RESPONSE TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING

To the Honorable Administrative Law Judge Von Qualen:

Viridian Energy PA LLC ("Applicant") in Docket No. 13-0135 hereby respectfully submits responses to the Notice of Administrative Law Judge's Ruling issued on March 11, 2013 and hereby incorporates by reference herein all responses and information contained in its Amended Application dated March 15, 2013 and its Response to Administrative Law Judge's Ruling dated March 5, 2013, submitted concurrently. Applicant requests that the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission") grant it a certificate of service authority pursuant to Section 16-115 of the Public Utilities Act ("Act"). Applicant submits the following responses:

1. Applicant shall explain its business relationship with affiliates in Illinois having or applying for ARES certification. The Applicant must disclose whether it will collaborate with its affiliates when marketing new customers or conducting other ARES related functions. Applicant shall explain how the marketing strategies of it and its affiliates differ and/or are similar. In particular, Applicant shall explain how the affiliates compete for customers.

Please see Paragraph 14(a) of the Applicant's Amended Application dated March 15, 2013.

2. Applicant shall provide a verified statement from an officer of its parent Regional Energy Holdings, Inc. attesting that the amount of credit available (in the supply agreement/base confirmation) to the Applicant will at all times remain sufficient to meet its obligation pursuant to Section 451.320. This verified statement shall remain in effect while the applicant continues to use the financial qualification in Section 451.320(a)(2).



3. If Applicant will not be satisfied with an order for confidential treatment of the identified information for a period of two years, Applicant shall demonstrate why confidential treatment for five years is appropriate.

As stated in Applicant's Motion for Protective Order, Applicant is satisfied with an order of confidential treatment of the identified information for a period of two years.




