AMENDED APPLICATION

Viridian Energy PA LLC ("Applicant"), hereby requests that the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission") grant it a certificate of service authority pursuant to Section 16-115 of the Public Utilities Act ("Act"). Viridian Energy PA LLC is filing under subpart D of Part 451. In support of its application, Applicant states as follows:

REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL APPLICANTS [451.20]

1. State whether Applicant currently has authority from the Commission to be an ARES, and if so, the Docket Number under which such authority was granted.

Applicant currently has authority from the Commission to be an ARES under Docket Number 11-0348. Applicant requests that such current authority be consolidated with any authority granted pursuant to this application, under the docket number of this application.

2. A statement to disclose whether it is licensed as an alternative retail electric supplier in any other jurisdictions, similar to the licensure required under Section 16-115 of the Illinois Public Utilities Act. Additionally, the Applicant is directed to disclose whether it, or any of its affiliates, has had any complaints filed against it for its provision of any services in the electric or gas industry in this or any other jurisdiction. If yes, the Applicant is directed to include in its response the nature of the complaint, the jurisdiction, and the ultimate resolution.

Applicant who is licensed in Illinois under Docket Number 11-0348 currently holds licenses as an alternative retail electric supplier in New York (ESCO Code VRPA), Pennsylvania (Docket #A-2009-2145794), Maryland (License No. IR-

1840), New Jersey (License No. ESL-0084), the District of Columbia (Order #16446) and Delaware (Order #8178).

Applicant discloses all formal complaints or lawsuits that have been filed against it or any of its affiliates within three years of filing this application. For a listing of all formal complaints against Applicant or any of its affiliates, please see Amended Attachment A1. For a listing of all lawsuits against Applicant or any of its affiliates please see Amended Attachment A2.

For a chart listing every month that Applicant had pending a formal complaint compared to Applicant's total number of customers, please see Amended Attachment A3. For a chart listing every month that an affiliate had pending a formal complaint compared to that affiliate's total number of customers, please see Amended Attachment A4.

For a listing of any actions commenced by a regulatory authority by Applicant or any of its affiliates please see Amended Attached A9.

Please note that although Public Power LLC currently is licensed as an Alternative Retail Electricity Supplier, as of December 31, 2012, it has ceased marketing in the state of Illinois.

Please note that Regional Energy Holdings, which was formed in 2009 as a holding company that owns a portfolio of energy services companies, did not start tracking complaints until February of 2010 and the totals for Public Power have just recently been gathered. Amended Attachment A1 through Amended Attachment A9 are filed separately and confidentially with the Illinois Commerce Commission. Applicant requests that Amended Attachment A1 through Amended Attachment A9 be given confidential treatment because this unique compilation of complaints and complaint statistics is not publicly available.

In fall 2012, a change occurred to Applicant's corporate organizational structure. On September 18, 2012, Regional Energy Holdings, Inc. ("REH"), and Public Power LLC ("Public Power") combined to form Crius Energy LLC ("Crius"). Crius was formed to effectuate a combination through an exchange of stock and membership units of the two companies. As a result of the exchange transaction, Crus Energy became the owner of the majority interest in voting shares of REH and a majority interest in Public Power. REH's subsidiaries and Public Power and its subsidiaries are licensed as electricity and gas suppliers in

several states. Applicant's affiliates now include: Public Power LLC, a Connecticut limited liability company; Public Power LLC, a Pennsylvania limited liability company; Public Power & Utility of New Jersey LLC; Public Power & Utility of Maryland LLC; Viridian Network LLC; Viridian Energy LLC; Viridian Energy NY LLC; Cincinnati Bell Energy LLC; FairPoint Energy LLC and FTR Energy Services, LLC. A copy of Applicant's corporate organizational chart is provided in Amended Attachment B.

On November 13, 2013 there was an initial public offering ("IPO") in which units of Crius Energy Trust, (a Canadian Trust) were sold to the public on the Toronto Stock Exchange. The IPO raised funds for the acquisition of 26.8 percent of the ownership interests in Crius Energy LLC.

The Crius Energy officers are from the REH management team. Michael Fallquist is the CEO. Roop Bhullar, CFO, Cami Boehme, SVP of Marketing and Brand Strategy, Mike Chester, VP of Operations and Jan Fox, SVP and General Counsel report to Michael Fallquist.

3. Applicant certifies that it will comply with all applicable Federal, State, regional and industry rules, practices, policies, procedures and tariffs for the use, operation, maintenance, safety, integrity, and reliability of the interconnected electric transmission system; [451.20(a)]
4. Applicant agrees to submit good faith schedules of transmission and energy in accordance with applicable tariffs. [451.20(a)]
5. Applicant certifies that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements that the Commission may by rule establish; [451.20(b)]
6. Applicant certifies that it will provide for review by Staff on a confidential and proprietary basis data related to contracts for the purchase and sale of electric power and energy; [451.20(b)]

8. The Applicant shall demonstrate that:

- a) Applicant is licensed to do business in the State of Illinois, as demonstrated in Amended Attachment C. [451.20(d)(1)]
- b) Applicant's employees that will be installing, operating, and maintaining generation, transmission, or distribution facilities within the State of Illinois, as well as any entity with which the Applicant has contracted to perform those functions, have the requisite knowledge, skills, and competence to perform those functions in a safe and responsible manner in order to provide safe and reliable service in accordance with the criteria stated in Section 16-128(a) of the Act [220 ILCS 5/16-128(a)]. [451.20(d)(2)]

This section is does not apply to Applicant. Applicant will not install, operate, or maintain generation, transmission, or distribution facilities within the State of Illinois.

- 9. Applicant shall certify compliance with all other applicable laws and regulations and Commission rules and orders; [451.20(e)]
- 10. Applicant shall certify it will procure renewable energy resources as required by Section 16-115D and subsection (d) of Section 16-115 of the Act, or shall certify

that Section 16-115D and subsection (d) of Section 16-115 of the Act do not apply to it pursuant to subsection (h) of Section 16-115D of the Act. [451.20(f)].

Applicant certifies that it will procure renewable energy resources as required by Section 16-115D and subsection (d) of Section 16-115 of the Act.

11. Applicant shall certify that it will source electricity from clean coal facilities, as required by Section 16-115(d)(5) of the Act. [451.20(g)]

12. Applicant will publish notice of its application for certification in the Official State Newspaper within 10 days following its filing of the application for certification. The applicant will file proof of publication with the Clerk of the Commission within 5 days after publication. [451.30(a)]

Applicant published notice of its application for certification in the Official State Newspaper on February 15, 2013. Proof of publication was mailed by USPS on February 27, 2013 and was entered into Docket 13-0135 on March 5, 2013. Please see Amended Attachment D for the proof of publication.

13. Applications for certification shall be verified as required by Section 200.130 of the Commission's "Rules of Practice" (83 Ill. Adm. Code 200.130)
14. Geographic area in which Applicant seeks to be authorized to offer service (if less than entire State, provide detailed description) and the types of services it intends to offer. [451.30(c)]

Applicant seeks to provide retail electricity service to residential, commercial and industrial customers in the Ameren Illinois and Commonwealth Edison service territories.

- a) Description of Applicant's business. Applicant is not affiliated with an Illinois utility. [451.30(c)(1)]

Applicant will supply electricity to residential, commercial, and industrial customers in Illinois as an Alternative Retail Electric Supplier. Applicant anticipates chiefly competing on the basis of price, but will also place a high priority on customer satisfaction.

Applicant, Viridian Energy PA LLC, is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Regional Energy Holdings Inc. Regional Energy Holdings Inc. is a subsidiary of Crius Energy LLC. Both Regional Energy Holdings, Inc. and Crius Energy LLC operate as holding companies for a family of energy brands. Please see Amended Attachment B for corporate organizational chart and Paragraph 2 for a more detailed explanation.

Applicant and its affiliates: Cincinnati Bell Energy LLC, FairPoint Energy LLC, FTR Energy Services, LLC and Public Power LLC and its Public Power operating subsidiaries each have a unique business model. Applicant's business model is different from that of its affiliates in several ways:

- Marketing –
  - Viridian Energy PA LLC (Applicant): Applicant markets its product through a network of independent contractors. These independent contractors are permitted to market Applicant's products and services to individuals that they personally know. Applicant's independent contractors are not permitted to cold-call over the telephone or market door-to-door. Applicant's independent contractors are closely regulated by Applicant and according to their contract with Viridian may not provide marketing services for other retail energy service providers. Calls on behalf of Viridian are made from a Customer Retention call center that is staffed with employees of the parent company, Crius Energy
  - Cincinnati Bell Energy LLC, FairPoint Energy LLC, FTR Energy Services LLC: These affiliates of Applicant have strategic business relationships with leading telecommunications companies. Marketing is conducted primarily through inbound calls made by existing customers to employees of the telecommunications companies who are trained to sell energy. These affiliates market through the respective telecommunication provider's employees. Occasionally outside vendors are used to provide marketing services.
  - Public Power LLC: This affiliate of Applicant markets its products through outbound and inbound telemarketing and door-to-door marketing. Marketing services are provided by external contracted vendors and their agents. Retention calls on behalf of Public Power are made from a Customer Retention call center that is staffed with employees of the parent company, Crius Energy.
  
- Customer Service – Customer service for Applicant and all of its affiliates is provided by employees of the parent company, Crius Energy. A

customer call center that services all Crius Energy subsidiaries is operated out of the Crius Energy headquarters in Stamford, Connecticut.

- Solicitation of New Customer Contracts –
  - Viridian Energy PA (Applicant): Applicant's independent contractors may solicit new customer contracts from friends and family or people they know personally. Applicant also allows for online enrollments.
  - Public Power LLC: This affiliate solicits new customer contracts through outbound and inbound telemarketing and door-to-door marketing activities provided by vendors that the affiliate has contracted with.
  
- Termination of Customer Contracts – Any requested termination of customer contracts are handled by Crius Energy employees for all affiliate companies.
  
- Offers to Customers –
  - Viridian Energy PA (Applicant): Applicant may make offers to existing customers through Company approved print correspondence. For example, a customer nearing the end of a fixed-rate term will receive a notice of contract expiration and an offer to renew their fixed rate. These offers are created and executed by Crius Energy employees. Applicant's independent contractors have an ongoing relationship with their customers and may convey offers to customers supported by the parent company.
  - Public Power LLC: Public Power may make offers to existing customers who have cancelled their future service by offering incentives to renew or reenroll. These offers are made by Crius employees out of the Customer Retention call center.

Applicant is not affiliated with an Illinois utility, however as a result of the corporate structure, Applicant has affiliate relationships with the other subsidiaries of Crius Energy LLC. One of Applicant's affiliates, Public Power LLC, is licensed as Alternative Retail Electricity Suppliers in Illinois, but ceased marketing in Illinois as of December 31, 2012. Another of Applicant's affiliates, FTR Energy Services, LLC is licensed as an Alternative Gas Supplier in Illinois and has a pending application before the Illinois Commerce Commission to become an Alternative Retail Electricity Supplier. Applicant and its affiliates are separate operating entities that each pursue a different marketing strategy and have distinct corporate brands. Applicant has a renewable energy value proposition and uses independent contractors marketing solely to their personal contacts. Public Power LLC markets to customers through telemarketing and door-to-door solicitation. FTR Energy Services is a strategic business relationship with the telecommunication company Frontier Communications and primarily markets to Frontier customers through inbound calling to Frontier. Because each entity markets

to customers differently, the entities do not directly compete with one another. Applicant and its affiliates do not collaborate with one another when marketing to new customers. Applicant and its affiliates are completely separate operating entities with common ownership.

- b) Description of the characteristics of customer group(s) Applicant proposes to serve. [451.30(c)(2)]

Applicant is applying for certification under Subpart D to serve all classes of retail customers. Specifically, Applicant proposes to serve residential, commercial and industrial customers.

- c) Proof that Applicant notified the designated in-state agent for each affected utility that Applicant intends to serve customers in that utility's service area, as demonstrated in Amended Attachment E. [451.30(c)(3)]

15. The Applicant shall certify compliance with all terms and conditions required by Sections 16-115A(a), (b), and (f), 16-119, 16-123, 16-125(b) and (c), 16-127, and 16-128(a) of the Act, to the extent those Sections have application to the services being offered by the alternative retail electric supplier; [451.30(d)(2)]

17. Applicant agrees to accept service by electronic means. [451.30(e)]

CUSTOMER RECORDS AND INFORMATION [451.40]

18. Applicant agrees to adopt and follow rules and procedures ensuring that authorizations received from customers, customer billing records, and requests for delivery service transmitted to utilities are retained for a period of not less than two calendar years after the calendar year in which they were created. [451.40(a)]

19. Applicant agrees to adopt and follow rules and procedures to preserve the confidentiality of its customer's data. [451.40(b)]

LICENSE OR PERMIT BOND REQUIREMENTS [451.50]

20. Applicant is required to execute and maintain a copy of the license or permit bond in the name of the People of the State of Illinois issued by a qualifying surety or insurance company authorized to transact business in the State of Illinois. The amount of the bond shall equal the amount specified in Part 451.50(a) for the appropriate group of customers the Applicant seeks certification to serve.

A copy of Applicant's permit bond as well as proof that the surety meets the definition of qualifying surety is provided in Amended Attachment F.

FINANCIAL QUALIFICATIONS [451.320]

21. Applicant meets one of the six financial criteria set forth in Part 451.110(a)(1-6), 451.220(a)(1-6), or 451.320(a)(1-6), as demonstrated in Amended Attachment G1 and Attachment G2.

Amended Attachment G5 filed confidentially and separately contains a schedule showing a calculation of 10% of the revenue of Applicant's certified financial statements.

Applicant has filed Amended Attachment G2, Amended Attachment G3 and Amended Attachment G5 separately and confidentially in the above-styled proceeding because they contains highly sensitive protected information as further set forth in the Motion for Protective Order and *Pro Hac Vice* filed simultaneously with this Application. The information presented in Amended Attachment G2, Amended Attachment G3 and Amended Attachment G5 is not publicly available.

22. Applicant will not provide electric power and energy with property, plant and equipment that it owns, controls, or operates.

23. Applicant will not use electric generation, transmission or distribution facilities that it owns, controls or operates in serving customers.

Applicant meets the requirements of Part 451.330 as demonstrated in Amended Attachment H, Amended Attachment I, and below.

Crius Energy LLC is a holding company for a family of energy brands. Employees of Crius Energy Management LLC exclusively operate or provide services for all of the licensed brands, which include Viridian Energy PA LLC. Viridian Energy PA LLC is a wholly owned subsidiary of Regional Energy Holdings Inc. Regional Energy Holdings Inc. is a wholly owned subsidiary of Crius Energy LLC. Please see Amended Attachment H, filed confidentially, for a services agreement between Viridian Energy PA LLC and Regional Energy Holdings, Inc. Please refer back to Amended Attachment B for Applicant's corporate organizational chart.

Amended Attachment I contains the résumés of individuals from Applicant's staff with relevant experience Applicant believes satisfies the applicable technical experience requirements, including the duration of that experience.

Applicant does not own generation, transmission, or distribution facilities so the question concerning the individuals on Applicant's staff having experience working with Applicant's facilities or an electric generation, transmission, or distribution facility that is substantially similar to the facility that Applicant owns does not apply.

The following individuals on Applicant's staff have experience buying and selling power and energy in wholesale markets: Michael Fallquist—Chief Executive Officer; Roop Bhullar—Chief Financial Officer; Michael Chester—Vice President, Operations, Steve Bogin—Gas Scheduler; and Eric Wilkins—Power Supply Manager. The following individuals on Applicant's staff have at least four years of experience buying and selling power and energy in wholesale markets: Steve Bogin—Gas Scheduler. Please see Amended Attachment I for the résumés of the above listed staff members.

The following individuals on Applicant's staff have at least one year of scheduling experience working for an entity that is either a member of PJM, a market participant in the Midwest ISO, or has a system operator certificate from NERC, or has earned Certified Energy Procurement Professional status by the Association of Energy Engineers (or equivalent certification): Steve Bogin—Gas Scheduler and Eric Wilkins—Power Supply Manager. Please see Amended Attachment I for the résumés of the above listed staff members.

25. Applicant is not relying on one or more agents or contractors to meet the technical and managerial requirements of Part 451.120 and 451.130, 451.230 and 451.240, 451. 330 and 451.340, or 451.420.

FINANCIAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR SINGLE BILLING SERVICE [451.510]

26. Applicant does not intend to provide single billing services.

GENERAL PROVISIONS FOR APPLICANTS FILING UNDER SUBPART D [451.310]

27. Subpart C and D applicants must certify compliance with all terms and conditions required by Section 16-115A(c) of the Act. [451.210 and 451.310(a)]

Applicant certifies compliance with all terms and conditions required by Section 16-115A(c) of the Act, as required by 451.310(a).

28. Applicant shall state any limitations that will be imposed on the number of customers or maximum load to be served and certify that it will not deny service to a customer or group of customers nor establish any differences as to prices, terms, conditions, services, products, facilities, or in any other respect, whereby such denial or differences are based on race, gender or income nor deny service to a customer or group of customers based on locality nor establish any unreasonable differences as to prices, terms, conditions, services, products, or facilities as between localities. Applicant does not have any limitations on the number of customers or maximum load to be served.

29. Applicant has not been denied an electric supplier license in any state in the United States. [451.310(c)(1)]
30. Applicant has not had an electric supplier license suspended or revoked by any state in the United States. [451.310(c)(2)]

31. Applicant does not have other electric supplier license applications pending in any state in the United States. [451.310(c)(3)]
32. Applicant is not the subject of any lawsuits that were filed in a court of law or formal complaints that were filed with a regulatory agency alleging fraud, deception or unfair marketing practices, or other similar allegations. [451.310(c)(4)]
33. Applicant certifies that its marketing materials which make statements concerning prices, terms and conditions of service contain information that adequately discloses the prices, terms and conditions of the products or services that the Applicant is offering or selling to the customer. [451.310(d)(1)]
34. Applicant certifies that before any customer is switched from another supplier, Applicant will give the customer written information that adequately discloses, in plain language, the prices, terms and conditions of the products and services being offered and sold to the customer. [451.310(d)(2)]
35. Applicant certifies it will provide documentation to the Commission and to customers that substantiates any claims made by the Applicant regarding the technologies and fuel types used to generate the electricity offered or sold to customers. [451.310(d)(3)]
36. Applicant certifies it will provide to the customer itemized billing statements that describe the products and services provided to the customer and their prices, and provide an additional statement, at least annually, that adequately discloses the average monthly prices, and the terms and conditions, of the products and services sold to the customer. [451.310(d)(4)]
37. Applicant certifies it will include materials comprising the consumer education program (pursuant to Section 16-117 of the Act [220 ILCS 5/16-117]) with all initial mailings to potential residential and small commercial retail customers and


before executing any agreements or contracts with such customers, and that Applicant will provide these materials at no charge to residential and small commercial retail customers upon request. [451.310(e) and 451.310(f)]

38. Applicant certifies it will provide to residential and small commercial retail customers on a semiannual basis information on how to obtain a list of alternative retail electric suppliers that have been found in the last 3 years by the Commission (pursuant to Section 10-108 of the Act [220 ILCS 5/10-108]) to have failed to provide service in accordance with the terms of their contracts (pursuant to Section 16-117(g)(4)(C) of the Act). [451.310(g)]
39. Applicant certifies it will maintain sufficient managerial resources and abilities to provide the service for which it has a certificate of authority. [451.340(d)]

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that the Commission grant its application for service authority to serve retail customers in all customer classes throughout the State of Illinois.




