1 JUDGE BAKER: Pursuant to the
2 authority of the Illinois Commerce Commission, I
3 now call Docket 13-0074. 365 Wireless, LCC, and
4 TDS Metrocom. This is a joint petition for
5 approval of a negotiated interconnection and
6 reciprocal compensation agreement.

7 Will the parties please state
8 their name for the record.

9 MS. CISNEROS: Katie Cisneros
10 appearing for TDS Metrocom.

11 MS. ERICSON: On behalf of
12 Commission staff, Christine Ericson, 160 North
13 LaSalle Street, Suite C-800, Chicago, Illinois
14 60601.

15 JUDGE BAKER: Okay. Counsel, have
16 you had an opportunity to review the agreement?

17 MS. ERICSON: Yes, your Honor.
18 Staff has filed and served the verified statement
19 of A. Olusanjo Omoniyi. Mr. Omoniyi recommends
20 approval of the agreement finding nothing
21 discriminatory and nothing against the public
22 interest. Staff recommends that TDS Metrocom be

1 required to file -- to create and file a current
2 list of valid interconnection agreements within
3 five days from the date the negotiated agreement
4 is approved. If TDS Metrocom enters into
5 additional negotiated agreements in the future,
6 those agreements should be added to the list.

7 Staff further recommends that
8 TDS Metrocom file a verified statement with the
9 ICC clerk's office verifying that the agreement is
10 the same as the agreement filed in this docket so
11 that the Commission can put this agreement on the
12 Commission website.

13 In view of that, I will identify
14 the verified statement of A. Olusanjo Omoniyi as
15 found on Commission E-docket as Staff Exhibit 1
16 and move that it be admitted into record evidence.

17 (Document marked as Staff
18 Exhibit No. 1 for
19 identification.)

20 MS. ERICSON: I note for the record
21 that it was filed on March 14th, 2013, at
