PETITION TO INTERVENE

NOW COME Loren H. Wiese, Patricia Ann Wiese, Len L. Wiese and Leslie D. Wiese, individually, and Loren H. Wiese, as president of Loren H. Wiese, Inc., an Illinois corporation (hereinafter referred to collectively as "Wiese Farms"), all of whom are owners of farm land in Pike County, Illinois and Brown County, Illinois, which farm land is in the geographical area that is the subject of this proceeding, by and through their attorneys, March, McMillan, DeJoode and Duvall, P.C., and for their Petition to Intervene in this proceeding, state the following:

1. A Petition was filed by Petitioners herein initiating this proceeding on November 7, 2012.
2. The Petition herein seeks approval from the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission") for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, pursuant to Section 8-406.1 of the Illinois Public Utilities Act, and an Order pursuant to Section 8-503 of the Public Utilities Act, to Construct, Operate and Maintain a New High Voltage Electric Service Line and Related Facilities in the Counties of Adams,

Brown, Cass, Champaign, Christian, Clark, Coles, Edgar, Fulton, Macon, Montgomery, Morgan, Moultrie, Pike, Sangamon, Schuyler, Scott and Shelby, Illinois.

3. The landowners comprising Wiese Farms own land in the projected path of the a Primary Route proposed by Petitioners herein and will therefore be substantially affected by any decision of the Illinois Commerce Commission in this proceeding.
4. Accordingly, Wiese Farms seeks to intervene and be treated as an active party to this proceeding, in order to formally protect its collective interests in this matter.
5. Wiese Farms agrees to accept service by electronic means as provided for in Section 200.1050 of the Commission's Rules of Practice. Such service shall be made upon the attorneys of record for Wiese Farms.

WHEREFORE, Wiese Farms respectfully requests that the Hearing Examiner grant the undersigned Wiese Farms leave to be joined as an active party to this proceeding.






