EMERGENCY MOTION TO ORDER COMED TO KEEP THE LIGHTS ON IN THE PREMISES UNTIL TRIAL AND DECISION IS RENDERED IN THE CASE.

Now comes Plaintiff, Melcina Blanton files this Emergency Motion Captioned above and in support states as follows:

ILLINOIS COMMERCE COMMISSION Lawfully has Jurisdiction of the Disputed Billing Charges Case and has set the Date 4/18/2013 for Trial of the Case.

On March 26, 2013 Commonwealth Edison Company ("ComEd") Issued "Final Notice Prior to Disconnection". "Exhibit A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Our Legal System do not permit ComEd take the Law into its hand and engage in Acts threatening Plaintiff to pay or Electricity will be Disconnected Where Payment of Electricity Servic Charges has been Lawfully Disputed in a Case filed with a Statutory Body of Lawful Jurisdiction and Trial of the Case is already Set.

As a result of the foregoing, ComEd threat of Electricity Disconnection is premature, Violates Due Process and Equal Protection of Law for cause Trial is Pending and the Commission has not render a Decision that found Plaintiff Liable for the sum of money ComEd is claiming for electricity charges.

ComEd thinks of itself a Monopoly above the Law and do whatever it wants and has no Respect for Law and Order and Legal Process and Disdain for Illinois Commerce Commission and the Courts.

Further, ComEd failed to Issue the First Ordinary Warning Notice demanding payment; a necessary requirement before a Final Notice Prior to Disconnection. For Cause, therefore, this ComEd Final Notice is Invalid Null and Void.


The only Rationale for this ComEd Bad Faith Sudden Rush of Final Notice Prior to Disconnection on April 5, 2013 to threaten and force payment of Electric Charges by Plaintiff 14 Days before Trial is Con Scheme by ComEd to (a) thwart the Trial set by the Commission and render the Case Mute. (b) Cover-Up ComEd Wrong Doing of Fraudulent Billing Practices and Charges from being looked into by the Commission. (d) Avert ComEd submission of Documents and Materials sought by Plaintiff's Discovery.

This Final Notice by ComEd constitutes forcible collection of Disputed Billing Charges from Plaintiff and make ComEd Judge, Jury and Executioner, thwart the Scheduled Trial and render the Case Mute and Deprive Due Process of Law and Justice.

**RELIEF**

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff Pray the Commission Order ComEd to Keep the Lights On in the premises until Trial is held and Decision rendered by the Commission and Legal Process complete.


