Dear City of Aurora Resident,

In March 2012, voters in the City of Aurora approved a referendum allowing the community to contract with an energy supplier to reduce electricity costs for its residents. The City of Aurora is pleased to announce it has chosen FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. as the supplier for the aggregation program due to the competitive rate they are able to provide. In addition, the electricity for the City of Aurora program will be 100% renewable. The City of Aurora residents will receive a rate of 4.71 cents per kWh. This compares very favorably with the estimated ComEd rate of 7.77 cents per kWh. This partnership will greatly benefit residents of the City of Aurora, and continues through the August 2014 billing cycle.

Electric Space Heat customers have also been included in the aggregation. The aggregation rate of 4.71¢ is 28% lower than ComEd's Space Heat rate of 6.50¢ per kWh.

Please note this rate is for the energy supply only and ComEd will continue to deliver your electricity. You will continue to receive a single, easy-to-read bill from ComEd with your FirstEnergy Solutions charges included and you will continue to make payments directly to ComEd. The bill will also include the ComEd delivery charges and taxes. ComEd will continue to deliver your service and respond to any disruptions.

You will see your electric savings from FirstEnergy Solutions after your enrollment has been completed and your switch has been finalized – approximately 60 days, depending upon your meter read date. You are not obligated to participate in the City of Aurora electricity aggregation program. If you wish to be excluded from the program and remain a full-service customer of ComEd, you have until August 10, 2012 to return the attached "opt-out" form.

After you become a participant in this electricity aggregation program, ComEd will send you a letter confirming your selection of FirstEnergy Solutions as your electric generation provider. As required by law, this letter will inform you of your option to cancel your contract with FirstEnergy Solutions within seven days of its postmark. **To remain in the City of Aurora electricity aggregation program, you do not need to take any action when this letter arrives.**



How is Bannockburn able to choose a certified electricity supplier on the community's behalf and who is eligible?

Bannockburn residents voted to give the Village of Bannockburn the ability to negotiate on behalf of the community for a contract for an electricity supplier. All current participants in the program will receive notice of the new program rates, terms and conditions, and continue to be eligible. Newly eligible residents or businesses have been sent an opt-in notice and meet the following Constellation Energy requirements:

1. You are not currently served by another electricity supplier other than the utility.
2. You are not a PIPP (percentage of income payment program) customer.
3. You are not in arrears on your bill payment.
4. Your service address is located within Bannockburn **city** limits.
5. Your utility company must be ComEd.
6. You are not a mercantile customer (electricity commercial accounts using over 15,000 kWhs per year).

What is Governmental Aggregation and how can I benefit?

Under governmental aggregation, local officials bring the community together for improved group purchasing power. You benefit by receiving competitively-priced electricity from a retail supplier certified by the Illinois Commerce Commission.

Am I charged tax on the electricity use?

Yes. County sales tax is assessed on the supply charges only. All electricity users will pay their respective county sales tax regardless of supplier.

Where do I send payment?

Send your payment to the same place you do now. Constellation Energy's energy charges will appear as a line item on the bill you receive from ComEd and you will continue to remit one monthly payment to ComEd. Since ComEd delivers the electricity to your home or business, they continue to charge for delivery.

I am currently under the budget billing option as provided by ComEd. Can I retain this service?

There will be no changes in your bill as they relate to budget billing and the methodology utilized by ComEd to calculate the same. If you are interested in receiving budget billing, please contact ComEd at 1-800-334-7661 to sign up for this billing plan. If you are currently on budget billing with ComEd, it will continue even if you enroll in the Bannockburn Electricity Program.

What if I'm with another supplier and would like to join the Village's program?

Please check your current supplier contract to determine if you are able to terminate your current supply agreement. Your current supplier may charge a penalty for early termination.

Are there cancellation fees if I cancel early?

In the Bannockburn Electricity Program, you have the ability to cancel your agreement at any time by paying an early termination fee of \$50.00. Please see our terms and conditions for additional detail, including circumstances in which you may not be required to pay an early termination fee.

As a result of electric de-regulation in Illinois, the Village of Hinsdale established an electric aggregation program that enables them to aggregate the load of all consumers within the Village of Hinsdale in order to negotiate a discount on electricity rates.

The Village of Hinsdale has selected Nordic Energy to be your electric provider. Nordic Energy Services, LLC ("Nordic") is an independently owned Chicago based energy management firm specializing in energy management services including energy procurement, customized energy risk management services and effective energy operating cost reduction strategies. Nordic also specializes in the re-sale and marketing of natural gas in Illinois and Indiana as well as electric power under both ComEd and Ameren.

Nordic is able to offer Hinsdale residents a fixed price of \$.0463/kWh which represents a **savings of 40% off the current ComEd rate**. Additionally, residents will receive price protection with a three year fixed rate. ComEd will continue to send you a monthly invoice and your invoice will include Nordic's reduced energy charges. Also, ComEd will continue to deliver your energy in a safe and reliable way.

In order to be eligible to participate in the Village of Hinsdale Aggregation Program, you must have a residence located in the Village of Hinsdale. If you do not have a residence located in the Village of Hinsdale please call us at 1-877-808-1022.

If you are interested in saving money on your electric charges, you don't need to do anything. Nordic will automatically enroll your account(s) in the Village of Hinsdale Municipal Aggregation Program.

Following the passage of a voter referendum on March 20, 2012, the Village of Hinsdale contracted with Nordic Energy Services, L.L.C. to procure lower-cost electric supply.

All residents and small commercial accounts will automatically be enrolled unless they have already switched their ComEd electric account to an alternate supplier or are in a Residential Real-Time Pricing (RRTP) program. There is no enrollment fee.

If you have already switched your electric account from ComEd to an alternate supplier, or you are on ComEd's RRTP program, you will not automatically be enrolled in Hinsdale's electric aggregation program, but you may contact Nordic Energy directly at (877) 808-1022 to enroll. You should first confirm with your existing supplier whether canceling your contract would trigger an early termination fee. You could wait until your current contract expires and join the program at that time. There is no fee to join the aggregation.

The rate for Hinsdale's new electric aggregation program is 4.63 ¢ per kWh, a savings of 45.5 percent off the new ComEd rate of 8.5 cents per kWh. Residents using an average electric load in Hinsdale may save up to \$690 in the first year upon joining the program. The Village of Hinsdale's contract is for a term of three years.

Residents receiving electricity from an alternate supplier are advised to review their contract to determine whether they are subject to an early termination fee before enrolling in the Village's program. They can choose to enroll when the program begins, or they may choose to wait until their current contract expires and join the Village's program at that time by contacting Nordic directly. Do not call the Village Hall to enroll.

Residents will continue to receive only one bill from ComEd and it will include the electric supply charges from Nordic Energy Services, L.L.C. 




