**VERIFIED PETITION**

COMES NOW Ameren Illinois Company d/b/a Ameren Illinois (“AIC” or the “Company”), and for its Petition, states as follows:

1. Rider TS is applicable to customers taking service under AIC’s Delivery Service Rates, Rate DS-1 through DS-5, and who are receiving company supplied power and energy. The purpose of Rider TS is to provide for the recovery of costs, fees and charges related to Transmission Service and other related services necessary for the provision of power and energy by AIC. The affected charges are rendered pursuant to the Transmission Provider’s FERC-approved tariffs for related transmission service, excluding the transmission and other related service costs recovered under Riders PER and HSS, as applicable.

2. Pursuant to an amendment to Rider TS, AIC is to file a Petition annually with the Illinois Commerce Commission (“Commission”) no later than April 30, seeking initiation of an annual review to provide for correction of any accounting errors that may occur in the application of Rider TS for the prior year. The Information submitted accompanying this Petition should allow the Commission to verify: 1) costs recoverable through Transmission Service Charges during the reconciliation year, and 2) the revenue arising through the application of the Transmission Service Charges to applicable sales during the reconciliation year.

3. In support of its filing, see Ameren Exhibit 1 which are schedules that show the revenue and expenses as filed and compares them to the actual revenue (from the general ledger) and expenses (as calculated), as well as testimony in support thereof offered by Dominic S. Perniciaro (“Ameren Exhibit 1.0”).

WHEREFORE, Ameren Illinois Company respectfully requests that the Commission affirm the reconciliation with respect to the 12-month time period covering 2012, and for such other and further relief as deemed equitable and just.
