REQUEST NO. JLH 1.01:

Please state whether computation of the annual electric kWh energy deliveries served for ComEd as a whole for program year ("PY") 1 through PY6 is available in a form disaggregated for the customer sectors that DCEO's energy efficiency programs serve (projected energy or energy delivered, as applicable). If so, please provide low income and public sector load separately for the available program years.

RESPONSE:

ComEd objects to this request because it is overbroad and unduly burdensome to the extent it seeks information outside of the reconciliation period at issue in this docket or seeks information in a form not maintained by ComEd in the usual course of business. ComEd further objects to this request because it is neither relevant nor likely to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence in this docket. Without waiving these objections or any of ComEd's General Objections, ComEd states as follows. The public and low-income sectors served by DCEO's energy efficiency programs were uniquely identified and selected for purposes of filing the first energy efficiency and demand response plans under Section 8-103 of the Public Utilities Act. ComEd did not prepare computations of the annual electric kWh energy deliveries in a form disaggregated for these specific populations.
