**VERIFIED PETITION TO MAKE HOUSEKEEPING
AND TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO COMMONWEALTH EDISON COMPANY'S
FILED PERFORMANCE BASED DELIVERY SERVICE RATE FORMULA**

Commonwealth Edison Company (“ComEd”) hereby petitions the Illinois Commerce Commission (the “Commission” or “ICC”) under Sections 16-108.5(c) and 9-201 of the Illinois Public Utilities Act (“PUA”), 220 ILCS 5/16-108.5(c) and 9-201, to approve specific housekeeping and technical corrections to its delivery services rate formula. ComEd requests that these corrections be effective on or before 45 days from the date of this Petition.

In support thereof, ComEd states:

1. ComEd provides electric delivery services to approximately 3.8 million customers in Northern Illinois. ComEd is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Illinois with its principal business office in Chicago, Illinois, and management offices in DuPage and Will Counties, Illinois. ComEd is a public utility within the meaning of Section 3-105 of the PUA (220 ILCS 5/3-105), an electric utility within the meaning of Article XVI of the PUA (*see* 220 ILCS 5/16-102). ComEd is also a “participating utility” as defined in Section 16-108.5(b) of the PUA, 220 ILCS 5/16-108.5(b).

2. ComEd provides delivery services under performance based formula rates established pursuant to the Energy Infrastructure Modernization Act (“EIMA”), the common short name for the changes and additions made to the PUA by Public Acts 97-0616 and 97-0646. ComEd’s rate formula was first approved by the Commission Order dated May 29, 2012, in

Commonwealth Edison Co., ICC Docket No. 11-0721, as modified by the Commission Order on Rehearing dated October 3, 2012, in that Docket. In that Docket, the Commission approved as modified ComEd's performance based formula rate tariff, Rate DSPP – Delivery Service Pricing and Performance, and a set of filed, but non-tariff Schedules and appendices, collectively setting out the rate formula.

3. Subsequent housekeeping revisions and technical corrections have been made through the approval of the Commission in ICC Docket No. 11-0721 (including on rehearing). However, that Docket is now closed (subject to pending appeals). The ongoing cycle of annual update and reconciliation proceedings address cost and other inputs to the rate formula and the resulting delivery service charges, but do not permit modifications to the rate formula itself. Rather, putting aside exceptions not relevant here (*e.g.*, statutory revisions or orders on appeal), once the Docket establishing ComEd's rate formula is closed, Section 16-108.5 provides that “[s]ubsequent changes to the performance-based formula rate structure or protocols shall be made as set forth in Section 9-201 of this Act.” 220 ILCS 5/16-108.5(c).

4. In the course of preparing for and verifying the data for ComEd's 2013 annual formula rate update and revenue requirement reconciliation, which was initiated by a separate Petition filed earlier this week, ComEd discovered a limited number of housekeeping and technical corrections that should be made to the rate formula in order to ensure that it operates as provided by EIMA, and by the orders of the Commission. Also, several housekeeping changes would make the formula more readily understood. These proposed technical corrections and housekeeping revisions do not in any respect change the operation of the formula rate from its original intention as established by the Commission's orders, nor do they have any relationship

to any open issue now in dispute by ComEd or any other parties at the Commission, in the courts, or before the General Assembly.

5. The requested housekeeping and technical corrections are listed in the table below. In each case the location of the proposed revision, by Schedule or appendix and by line, is stated and the specific revision is identified.

For the further convenience of the Commission, Attachment A to this Petition contains the affected worksheets from ComEd’s existing rate formula filing showing the housekeeping and other technical corrections in legislative “redline” form. Attachment B is a complete “clean” version of the formula rate spreadsheet, including all Schedules and appendices, with the requested changes made. A working copy has been provided to Staff.

7. ComEd has consulted with Staff concerning this Petition and the need for the housekeeping and technical corrections. ComEd’s understands that Staff does not object to the substance of the corrections.


8. No party will be prejudiced by the allowance of this Petition and by making effective the housekeeping and technical corrections proposed.

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

I, Ross C. Hemphill, having first been duly sworn, state and aver as follows:


