Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois hereby submits the following fifth errata relating to its *Rebuttal Testimony*, as originally filed on the Illinois Commerce Commission’s e-Docket on April 26, 2013. The changes reflected in this errata are intended to address ministerial, computational or technical corrections required in and/or inadvertent omissions from the Company's Rebuttal Testimony, as provided for in 83 Ill. Adm. Code Section 200.670(d). Clean copies of the revised documents identified below are being filed contemporaneously with the errata and contain the following corrections.

Rebuttal Testimony and Exhibits:

ATXI 13.0 (2d Rev.) – Donell Murphy

1. On page 40, lines 851 – 853, after “This impact has not been addressed” delete the following: “MCPO’s alternate route from Pana to Kansas may also require the displacement (*i.e.*, removal of existing residences that would be within 75 feet of the centerline of the route.”;
2. On page 47, lines 1006 – 1007, delete the following sentence: “First, the route would require the displacement of at least two (2) residences.”;

3. In the following sentence on page 27, line 1007, delete the first word “Second” and capitalize the second word “the”;
4. On page 51, line 1101, delete the word “No” and replace with “Yes. Gan Properties opposes ATXI’s Alternate Route”.
