Dear Executive Director:

I am opposed to a proposal for the power line in the above case to go through Piatt and Douglas Counties. The proposal was developed in about two weeks by the Moultrie County Property Owners (MCPO), who are opposed to having the line in Moultrie County, and therefore have proposed a route which crosses only a very small part northeastern Moultrie County. On the other hand, Ameren spent considerable time over years in studying potential routes for this project, including a review of numerous geographic sensitivities, which concluded that Piatt and Douglas Counties were not feasible options. Ameren has disregarded all that work in stating that they would adopt the MCPO proposal. The MCPO proposal is inefficient and a waste of ratepayers money. The MCPO proposal essentially goes north of Mt. Zion, then east, and then south, whereas the best route that Ameren originally adopted ran from northwest to southeast (Mt. Zion to Kansas) through Moultrie County. This leaves the ICC with an important decision: To choose the original Ameren primary or alternate route, which is efficient and considers sensitivities, or to choose the inefficient MCPO route adopted at the last minute by Ameren. I urge the ICC Commissioners to choose the former.

I also do not believe that property owners in Douglas or Piatt Counties have had proper notice regarding the route through those counties. Indeed, to this day, Piatt and Douglas Counties are not even listed in the Ameren website as being impacted counties. Ameren has not followed the procedures they said they would follow.

Therefore, please reject the MCPO proposal and choose the primary or alternate route selected by Ameren before they adopted the MCPO proposal.


