**AMEREN TRANSMISSION COMPANY OF ILLINOIS’ SUPPLEMENT TO THE
SUGGESTED CORRECTIONS TO THE TRANSCRIPT OF THE MAY 13 – MAY 17,
2013 HEARING**

Pursuant to 83 Ill. Adm. Code 200.580, Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois (ATXI) filed suggested corrections to the transcript of the evidentiary hearing in this proceeding on June 18, 2013. ATXI’s suggested corrections to the Hearing Transcript were keyed to the transcript ATXI circulated to the ALJs and the parties on May 23, 2013, per the ALJs’ order. Subsequently, the court reporter filed the transcript on e-Docket over a series of days, concluding on June 3, 2013. It has come to ATXI’s attention that the pagination of the May 13, 14 and 17th Hearing Transcripts, as filed by the court reporter on e-Docket, diverges from the version circulated to the ALJs and the parties. For the convenience of the parties, ATXI now files this supplement to the suggested corrections to the Hearing Transcript, keying the suggested corrections to the version of the transcript as filed on e-docket. This will allow the parties to reference ATXI’s suggested corrections to either version of the transcript – the one circulated by ATXI on May 23, 2013 or the ones filed on e-Docket.
