MOTION FOR REHEARING

NOW COMES, Marcia Roa Wyett (the "Complainant"), who on January 14, 2013, filed a verified complaint alleging Commonwealth Edison ("ComEd") incorrectly calculated charges on her account. Complainant now requests that the Illinois Commerce Commission rehear the Order filed on or about July 10, 2013, for the following reasons:

- (1) After further review of the personal email Inbox located at marcia_roa@sbcglobal.net, Complainant acknowledges receiving two emails from Sender, Lori Bartolozzi (the "Sender") with a Subject Heading of "Official Commission Notice of Case or Proceeding – 13-0062," dated February 19th and March 28th, 2013. However, the emails were not opened on the date received, by the Complainant, since the Complainant did not recognize the sender's name and did not recognize the Subject Heading as being related to the Illinois Commerce Commission. Therefore, it was difficult to differentiate whether the two emails were, valid emails, or SPAM.
- (2) Furthermore, the two emails received, by the Sender, were not inclusive of all the electronic documents filed by Judge Bonita Benn, and posted to the Illinois Commerce Commission e-Docket located at, www.icc.illinois.gov. Therefore, Complainant did not have an all-inclusive document trail of what was occurring with the complaint file.
- (3) Complainant did not receive electronic or hard copies of the following: Notice of Continuance filed on February 22, 2013, and the Proposed Order filed on June 5, 2013.
- (4) Complainant was just recently made aware that documents related to the complaint, filed against ComEd, are posted to the Illinois Commerce Commissions website.
- (5) Complainant did not contact the Illinois Commerce Commission prior to July 9th, 2013, since, having knowledge in the legal field, realize that these types of matters take time to be docketed and heard before a Judge. However, after months of not receiving any mail notifications, got concerned and contacted Tracy Anderson at the Illinois Commerce Commission office in Springfield, IL, who directed Complainant to the Illinois Commerce Commission website's eDocket system.

WHEREFORE, the Complainant moves the Illinois Commerce Commission to grant a rehearing for the above-specified reasons. Complainant has every intention to proceed with the complaint filed against ComEd, should the request for rehearing be granted.
