PROCEEDINGS

JUDGE VON QUALEN: By the authority vested in me by the Illinois Commerce Commission, I now call Docket Number 13-0324. This docket was initiated by a petition filed by Ameren Illinois Company for the annual review of costs recoverable and revenues arising from Ameren's transportation service tariff known as Rider TS for the 2012 reconciliation year.
