


ICC COMPLAINT AGAINST COMED

Please note that ComEd has refused to provide us with an account because they state that our meters boxes are not proper. Please note that we pulled all required City of Chicago Permits and the meter boxes were inspected and approved per the City of Chicago Code. Thus, if ComEd is now requiring additional or different meter boxes then the meter boxes should be at ComEd's expense. ComEd's initial reason was that the meter boxes installed were not the proper size for their meters, subsequently, upon ComEd's inspection, they then changed their rationale and stated that they simply wanted us to install new meter boxes. Please note that this is a 26-unit residential apartment building and we are in need of a ComEd account.
