In this filing Ameren Illinois Company d/b/a Ameren Illinois ("Ameren Illinois" or "Company") presents, pursuant to Subsection 16-108.5(e) of the Public Utilities Act ("the Act"), revenue-neutral tariff changes related to the design of Ameren Illinois' performance-based formula rate, which is applied through the Company's Rate MAP-P – Modernization Action Plan – Pricing tariff ("Rate MAP-P"). In support of these proposed tariff changes and the underlying modifications to Ameren Illinois' rate design and cost of service methodologies, Ameren Illinois offers the testimony and related exhibits of three Company witnesses: (1) Mr. Leonard M. Jones, (2) Mr. Ryan K. Schonhoff, and (3) Mr. Steven D. Martin. For a further discussion of the testimony offered in support of this filing, please see the attached Supplemental Statement.

While each of the above-listed tariff sheets bears an effective date that is forty-five (45) after issuance, Ameren Illinois anticipates that these tariffs will be suspended by the Commission in order to conduct an investigation as provided by Subsection 16-108.5(e) of the Act. This Subsection

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provides that "[t]he Commission shall, after notice and hearing, enter its order approving, or approving with modification, the proposed changes to the performance-based formula rate tariff within 240 days after the utility's filing." As explained by Company witness Jones, the Company's Rate MAP-P tariff requires the revenue neutral rate changes to become effective during the next annual billing period, which begins in January, provided the changes are approved no sooner than 30 days prior. Assuming all or most of the 240 day schedule is used, the final order in this proceeding would be due in approximately mid-March 2014 and the changes approved in this proceeding would affect prices starting with the January 2015 billing period.

Enclosed for further distribution are a Supplemental Statement further explaining this filing, as well as two copies of this transmittal letter, the proposed tariff sheets (marked DUPLICATE), and the above-referenced testimony and related exhibits. As previously arranged with Mr. Scott Struck (Manager: Rates Department- Financial Analysis Division), two additional hard copies and one electronic copy of this filing are being provided directly to Mr. Struck at the Commission's Springfield Office. With the filing of this letter and the above-referenced tariff sheets, Ameren Illinois will also provide notice as required by Part 255 of the Commission's Rules of Practice.

Please acknowledge receipt of the enclosed filing by providing Ameren Illinois with a file-stamped copy of this transmittal letter.
