SECOND NOTICE OF MODIFICATION OF VIDEO SERVICE AREA

Pursuant to Section 401(g) of the Cable and Video Competition Law of 2007 (the “Law”) (220 ILCS 5/21-401(g)), Illinois Bell Telephone Company (“AT&T Illinois”) hereby notifies the Commission of a modification of the video service area footprint described in AT&T Illinois’ “Application for State-Issued Authorization to Provide Video Service” (the “Application”), which was approved in this docket on October 24, 2007, as modified by the “Notice of Modification of Video Service Area” (“First Notice of Modification”), filed in this docket on February 22, 2008.

In the Application, the video service area footprint where video service will be offered by AT&T Illinois during the term of State-issued authorization was described in terms of the exchanges (as that term is defined in Section 13-206 of the Public Utilities Act (“PUA”) (220 ILCS 5/13-206)) listed on pages 1 and 2 of Exhibit 1 of the Affidavit of Paul La Schiazza supporting the Application. (App. ¶ 10, Affidavit ¶ 5, Exhibit 1, pp. 1-2). The video service area footprint was modified by the First Notice of Modification by adding the exchanges listed on page 1 of Notice Exhibit 1 of the Affidavit of Mr. La Schiazza attached to that Notice. The video service area footprint is now being modified by further adding the exchanges listed on page 1 of Second Exhibit 1 of the attached Affidavit of Mr. La Schiazza supporting this Second Notice. (Second Notice Affidavit, ¶ 4). Page 2 of Second Notice Exhibit 1 identifies those local

units of government, not identified in the Application or First Notice of Modification or previously served a copy of the Application or First Notice of Modification, that include within their jurisdictional boundaries portions of the exchanges being added to the video service area. (Second Notice Affidavit, ¶ 4). Concurrently with the filing of this Second Notice of Modification, each of the local units of government listed on page 2 of Notice Exhibit 1 is being served a copy of the Second Notice, as well as a copy of the Application. (Second Notice Affidavit, ¶ 7).

Second Notice Exhibit 1 is marked as Confidential and Proprietary for the reasons discussed in paragraph 5 of the attached Affidavit. Consistent with Section 401(c)(1) of the Law (220 ILCS 5/21-401(c)(1)), the Commission is required to provide adequate protection of the information in Exhibit 1 pursuant to Section 4-404 of the PUA. (220 ILCS 5/4-404).

With the addition to AT&T Illinois' video service area of the exchanges listed in Confidential Second Notice Exhibit 1, the estimated number of low income households, as defined in Section 201(p) of the Law (220 ILCS 5/21-201(p)), located within the video service area, as modified, is 1.26 million. (Notice Affidavit, ¶ 6).

Under Section 401(g) of the Law, the Commission "is not required or authorized to act" upon this Notice.
