

Sergio Garcia operates Supermercado Mex #4 located at 9029 S. Commercial Avenue Chicago Illinois 60617 (773) 978-4981. The store has been at that location for 42 years.

The typical monthly electric bill is approximately \$1,500 to \$2,000.

Com ED recently charged this establishment with meter tampering. The meters are located securely within the building and are regularly read by Com Ed.

In addition to charging Supermercado with a \$542.23 for alleged tampering Com Ed is now charging Supermarcardo with a \$37,266.71 electric bill.

Finally Com Ed is threatening to disconnect the service.

A copy of the tampering charge letter of April 18, 2013, the \$37,266.71 bill and the disconnection notice are attached hereto.

Supermaracado believes the tampering charge is false and that it does not owe the \$37,266.71 bill.

Finally Supermarcardo asks that any efforts to discontinue service cease during the pendency of this formal complaint.
