Commonwealth Edison Company ("ComEd") encloses for filing with the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission" or "ICC") on May 30, 2013, the following tariff sheets from Rate DSPP – Delivery Service Pricing and Performance ("Rate DSPP"), as well as associated delivery service charges informational sheets and the Incremental Uncollectible Cost Factors informational sheet to be effective June 21, 2013:

Also enclosed for filing are rate formula spreadsheets attached hereto as Attachment A effecting changes in ComEd's delivery services formula rate. Pursuant to the Commission's Order in *Commonwealth Edison Co.*, ICC Docket No. 11-0721 (May 31, 2012) at 153, these spreadsheets may be filed, but are not themselves tariffs.

All of the documents submitted are filed with the Commission under the authority of Section 16-108.5(k) of the Public Utilities Act ("Act"), as amended by Public Act ("PA") 98-0015. They implement the specific changes to the formula rate and to revenue requirements relating to prior rate years required by PA 98-0015 and also provide a mechanism for those changes to translate effectively into both new future and revised current charges.

The Commission is required to review ComEd's filing and enter a final order in accordance with the PA 98-0015 within 21 days of this filing. See 220 ILCS 5/16-108.5(k)(1). However, the Commission may act sooner. As a result, no one can identify in advance the date on which the aforementioned tariff sheets, informational sheets, and formula rate changes will be effective. In order to address this fact, while providing the Commission with documents containing a stated effective date, each of the tariff sheets and informational sheets submitted with this letter bear an effective date of June 21, 2013, which is the first full day after the last day on which the Commission could lawfully act, and the formula rate spreadsheets will be attached to this letter. So that these documents will ultimately bear the correct effective date, ComEd asks that the Commission's order grant it, without need for further action, leave to file promptly revised documents (including a cover letter with attached formula rate spreadsheets) bearing an effective day that is one day after the day during which the Commission approves the documents being filed herewith. In any event, revised charges will not become effective until the commencement of each customer's July billing period, as provided by the tariff.

ComEd is aware that additional steps must also be taken to give full effect to PA 98-0015, but those steps are not part of this filing. Rather, to the extent that PA 98-0015 affects the testimony and data submitted in ComEd's recent 2013 formula rate update and reconciliation proceeding, ICC Docket No. 13-0318, ComEd will promptly file revised versions of the affected direct testimonies and exhibits in that docket via the ICC's e-docket system. ComEd will also submit revisions to the relevant data and documentation called for by the Commission's Standard Information Requirements promulgated in Part 285 of Title 83 of the Illinois Administrative Code ("Title 83") (83 Ill. Admin. Code Part 285) that were submitted with its original 2013 formula rate update and reconciliation filing.

Copies of this letter with the enclosures are also being sent to Mr. Gene Beyer (Bureau Chief, Bureau of Public Utilities), Harry L. Stoller (Director, Safety & Reliability Division), Mr. Jim Zolnierek (Director, Policy Division), and Mr. Scott Struck (Manager, Rates Department). Drafts of these submissions were also provided to, and have been reviewed by, the Staff members from the Rates, Accounting, and Finance departments, and this filing reflects their comments. Mr. Struck is also being provided with the populated rate design model used to determine the revised delivery service charges listed in the delivery service charges informational sheets electronically at sstruck@icc.illinois.gov.

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Two extra sets of this transmittal letter with its associated tariff sheets, informational sheets, and Attachment A are provided. One set of these documents is provided for your convenience in acknowledging receipt of this letter, and is to be returned to the ComEd representatives accompanying this filing.
