1 JUDGE KIMBREL: Pursuant to the authority of the
2 Illinois Commerce Commission, I now call Docket 13-0060,
3 WRPV, comma, XI Seneca Chicago, LLC, doing business as,
4 the Seneca versus Commonwealth Edison Company.

5 This is a petition for waiver to allow
6 redistribution of electricity for a multi-family
7 building.

8 Would the parties please identify themselves
9 for the record, including address and telephone number.

10 MS. JAGER: On behalf of Commonwealth Edison

14 MR. PERKINS: On behalf of Commonwealth Edison
15 Company, I'm Bradley R. Perkins, 10 South Dearborn,
16 Suite 4900, Chicago, Illinois 60680, phone number is
17 (312) 394-2632, and with us today is Erin Buechler with
18 ComEd.

19 MR. KRAUSE: This is Brett Krause for The Seneca.
20 The Seneca address is 200 East Chestnut Street, Chicago,
21 Illinois 60611. My address is 99 East 700 South, Logan,
22 Utah 84321, telephone number (435) 713-2136.

23 JUDGE KIMBREL: Okay. There was a brief discussion
24 off the record. Mr. Krause or Ms. Jager, would you like

1 to catch us up on where we stand today and what was
2 said?

3 MS. JAGER: Sure.

4 Commonwealth Edison Company requests 30 days
5 to file its answer in this case, which would place us
6 approximately at November 27th, 2013. And the parties
7 have agreed to a schedule going forward with Seneca's
8 direct testimony due on January 31st, 2014, ComEd's
9 direct testimony due on April 30th, 2014, Seneca's
10 rebuttal testimony due on May 30th, 2014, ComEd's
11 rebuttal testimony due June 30th, 2014 and Seneca's
12 surrebuttal testimony, if it chooses to file, July 14th,
13 2014 with a hearing to take place on July 29th and 30th
14 of 2014.

15 JUDGE KIMBREL: Okay.

16 Mr. Krause, do you have anything that you
17 would like to add?

18 MR. KRAUSE: Just that The Seneca agrees to both --
19 has no objection and agrees to both the timing for the
20 answer from ComEd and also for the schedule as
21 Ms. Jager set out.

22 JUDGE KIMBREL: Okay. Is there anything further
23 that we need to discuss?
