

JZ 6.18 At page 52 of Ms Harrison's Response Testimony she states "The intent of the disclaimer was simply for Millennium to express its disagreement with the performance measurements totals reported by AT&T."

A. Is the performance report information Millennium reported with respect to Code Part 730 and 732 to the Commission correct?

Response: According to the performance measurement reports from AT&T, the information reported on the 730 and 732 is correct.
