Professional Summary

Mr. Karr has over 30 years of experience in all facets of the energy industry. He began his career in the energy business with Natural Gas Pipeline Company of America (NGPL) as a geologist. He was selected to be Administrative Assistant to the President which allowed him to work in all areas of the company including contract administration and regulatory affairs during the mid 1980's, a period of deregulation of the interstate natural gas pipeline industry. This experience exposed Mr. Karr to Federal Energy Regulatory Commission orders and processes leading to the full deregulation of transportation of natural gas in the United States. FERC Order 436 opened interstate pipelines for the first time allowing local distribution companies to purchase natural gas directly from the producers, rather than the interstate pipelines. Mr. Karr's duties included negotiating termination or renegotiation of NGPL's contracts with the producers of natural gas feeding their pipeline.

Mr. Karr left NGPL in 1989 and for the next 10 years held various management level positions at Enron and Amoco in areas of sales and marketing of natural gas to local distribution companies across the Midwest and Mid-Atlantic states.

Mr. Karr was recruited by Washington Gas in Washington, D.C., to head a new division to sell gas and electric retail energy. Over a 2 year period, the new retail energy company grew exponentially and became an industry leading utility owned retail energy company that still exists today.

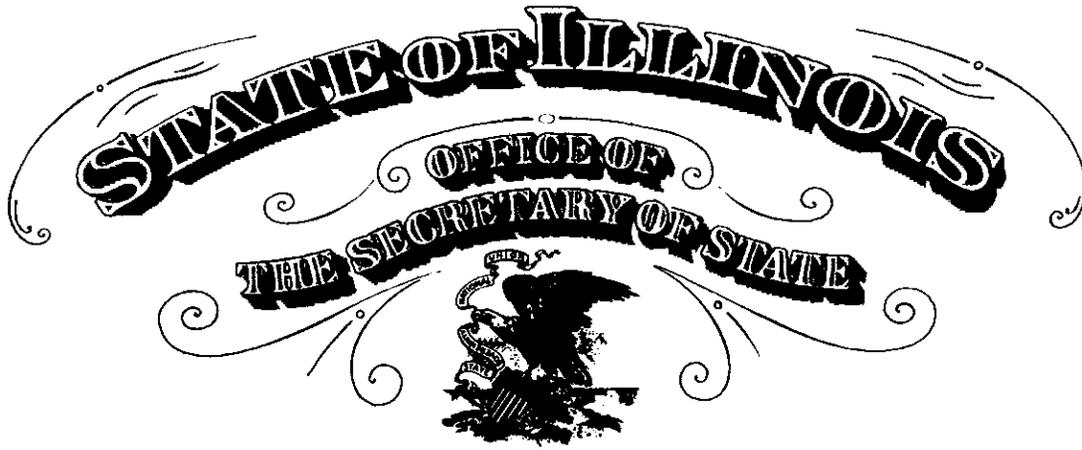
A joint venture of Dynegy and Nicor Gas formed the new electric and gas retail energy company, Nicor Energy LLC. Mr. Karr was recruited, and as Vice President he managed all facets of customer acquisition. He led a team of 60 sales professionals and 3 sales managers. During his tenure there, Nicor Energy grew from revenues in the low millions to over \$800 million.

In response to changes in regulation of the natural gas, electric power, and telecommunications industries, Mr. Karr left Nicor Energy to form AmAudit in 2002. The purpose of AmAudit is to improve the financial position of its clients by assisting them in identifying savings opportunities, recovering overpayments, and securing the most competitive rates for the utility services they consume. AmAudit accomplishes this through natural gas, electric, and telecom audits of utility bills, franchise agreements, and tax collections. AmAudit reviews contracts and applicable tariffs to identify saving opportunities. In addition, Mr. Karr worked with Senator Pam Althoff in drafting legislation that led to regulation of utilities and tax collection on behalf of municipalities across the State of Illinois.
