**PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTEVENE**

Pursuant to §200.30 of the Rules of Practice of the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission"), 83 Ill. Adm. Code 200.200, LYNN LANDMEIER and BETTY LANDMEIER ("Owners"), by and through their attorney, Stephen M. Burke, file this Petition for Leave to Intervene (their "Intervention"), seeking authority thereby to intervene and participate fully as parties in the above-captioned proceeding. In support of their Intervention, Owners state as follows:

1. On December 2, 2013, Commonwealth Edison Company ("ComEd") filed its Petition seeking both a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct, operate, and maintain an electric transmission line ("Transmission Line"), and an Order from the Commission authorizing and directing ComEd to construct said Transmission Line.

2. In ComEd's Petition, and its accompanying prepared written testimony and exhibits, ComEd proposed certain "Primary" and "Alternate" routes.

3. The Owners hold title to certain real property located in unincorporated Kane County comprising approximately 40 acres. As proposed, the Transmission Line will

bisect the Owners' property and will otherwise interfere with and impair the development of the land.

4. The parcels constituting the Owners' property are listed in ComEd's Petition.

5. Accordingly, the Owners are interested in the subject matter of this proceeding and may be affected by any order entered or other relief granted by the Commission.

6. No other party is able to adequately represent or protect the Owners' interests.

7. The Owners agree to accept service by electronic means as provided for in §200.1050 of the Commission's Rules of Practice. 83 Ill.Adm.Code §200.1050.




