**PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE**

Pursuant to Section 200.20 of the Rules of Practice of the Illinois Commerce commission ("Commission"), 83 ILL. Adm. Code 200.20, Thomas E. Nodurft, files this Petition for Leave to Intervene, on behalf of the Oak Ridge Farm Homeowners Association ("ORF HOA"), as its duly appointed President, seeking authority thereby to intervene and participate fully as a party in the above-captioned proceeding. In support of the Intervention, ORF HOA states as follows:

1. On December 2, 2013, Commonwealth Edison Company ("ComEd") filed its Petition seeking both a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct, operate, ad maintain an electric transmission line ("Transmission Line"), and an Order from the Commission authorizing and directing ComEd to construct the Transmission Line.
2. In ComEd's Petition and its accompanying prepared written testimony and exhibits, ComEd proposes certain "primary" and "alternate" routes.
3. The Oak Ridge Farm Homeowner's Association holds title to property, which includes three conservation/nature preserves and two ponds, and comprises 56 individual home sites, seven of which are immediately adjacent to the proposed transmission line route. As proposed, the route of the Transmission Line will be located within a few hundred feet of the homesites and will otherwise interfere with and impair the operation, use, and enjoyment of the properties.
4. Accordingly, the ORF HOA is interested in the subject matter of this proceeding and may be affected by any order entered or other relief granted by the Commission.
5. No other party is able to adequately represent or protect the ORF HOA's interests.
6. ORF HOA agrees to accept service by electronic means as provided for in §200.1050 of the Commission's Rules of Practice. 83 Ill. Admn. Code §200.1050.


