On February 25, 2014, the Citizens Utility Board (“CUB”) and the City of Chicago (“City”) filed an Initial Brief with the Illinois Commerce Commission (the “Commission”). On March 4, 2014, CUB/City filed a Reply Brief with the Commission. On March 5, 2014, CUB/City filed a Draft Proposed Order with the Commission. Errors have been identified in these exhibits. Therefore, CUB/City now submits the following errata to its testimony:

Sector Under the Spending Screen as Needed to Support the Inclusion of Air Sealing Measures and Comprehensive Multifamily Offerings.”


