



NOTICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING

Dear Sir/Madam:

Notice is hereby given that the Administrative Law Judge has completed a preliminary review of the application filed by Independent Energy Systems, Inc. ("Applicant") in Docket No. 14-0089, and hereby rules that a verified response, containing the information and clarifications described below, shall be filed with the Commission.

If filed electronically via the Commission's e-docket system, this verified response shall be filed with the Chief Clerk of the Commission on or before April 14, 2014. If the filing is made by non-electronic means, then April 14, 2014 is a mailing date. Applicant shall serve a copy of its response on the Administrative Law Judge (syoder@icc.illinois.gov). For purposes of doing so, April 14, 2014 is a receipt or "in hand" date, not later than 5:00 P.M., by electronic mail, Fax (217-524-8928) or otherwise.

Miscellaneous Additional Requirements

The Applicant is directed to disclose whether it is certificated by any public utility commissions in any State. If yes, the Applicant is directed to also disclose the jurisdiction in which it is certificated, and the type of certificate which was issued.

The Applicant is also directed to disclose whether it has had any complaints filed against it for its provision of any services in the electric or gas industry in this or any other jurisdiction. If yes, the Applicant is directed to include in its response the nature of the complaint, the jurisdiction, and the ultimate resolution of each complaint.
