Dear Sir or Madam:

I do not support Illinois Commerce Commission Docket Number 12-0598 regarding Ameren's proposed route to construct, operate, and maintain a new high voltage electric service line, specifically the Meredosia to Pawnee segment.

I live inside the city of Jacksonville so this project does not physically affect me, **however**, I understand there is a proposed power line corridor 18.3 miles shorter using the existing power line corridor between Meredosia and Pawnee. This will save us, Ameren customers, an estimated \$36.78 million dollars. In fact, a shorter corridor, parallel to the existing route, is the route that the Commission's technical Staff has been recommending all along.

I respectfully request that you, as a ICC Commissioner, take a strong look at this case because of the savings by using the existing Meredosia to Pawnee segment and approve the line as recommended by the Commission's own technical Staff.
