Ron,

I met the same comed guy (John) who insisted we have a copy of the bills. He looked at the bills for a few seconds and proceeded to tell me the building was drawing a lot of power according to his test. He said the building tested a 3, and that the lower the number meant more power was being used. He couldn't even tell me what kind of test or scale he was using! I told him I had tested the building for amps several times and it was always under 5 amps on 2 phases, 0 on the third phase. He then called someone who told him how to test for amps. I then watched him test for amps. He got a reading of less than one amp! But he was still telling me that the building was drawing lots of power! Unbelievable! He made no sense. He removed the old meter and installed a new one. He said they were going to test the old meter for problems. He said if the old meter tested ok the bills are correct. This must be the guy they send out to give people the runaround. They'll have the results on the meter test next week.
