3. The modified sections of the Plan are intended to comply with the terms and provisions of 50 ILCS 750 Emergency Telephone System Act.

1. Review the modified plan based on the information provided in the application and allow the parties to waive a hearing on this matter.
2. Enter an order approving the modifications of the existing plan submitted herewith and authorizing the implementation of said modification by the Champaign County Emergency Telephone System described herein.
