NOTICE TO LANDOWNER

The enclosed notice of a prehearing conference is being mailed to you because you have been identified as an owner of property along one of the routes upon which a utility proposes to construct facilities. Scheduling to address the utility proposal will be discussed at the prehearing conference described in the attached notice. No witness testimony will be taken on that date.

You are advised that the utility is seeking rulings that the proposed facilities are necessary and in the public interest and that the utility is authorized or directed to construct the facilities. In addition, the utility is seeking a ruling determining the proper location/routing of the proposed facilities. Whether the utility's preferred route for the utility facilities is the proper route will be determined in this proceeding. This proceeding is the only opportunity to contest the route of the utility facilities.

If the requested rulings are issued by the Commission and the proposed facilities are to be constructed on a route on your property, the utility will attempt to negotiate acquisition of certain property rights from you. If after reasonable attempts to do so, no arrangement can be made between you and the utility, the utility may file a petition with the Commission seeking authority to obtain certain property rights from you through eminent domain so that it may construct the proposed facilities. You should understand that, if your property lies in the path of the proposed facilities and the utility at some later date files a petition with the Commission seeking eminent domain authority to obtain property rights from you, the propriety of the route for the utility facilities will no longer be a matter to be contested.

You are invited to attend the prehearing conference should you desire. Participation by telephone may be available. Any person who wishes to present evidence regarding the necessity for or the location of the proposed facilities must intervene, or be called as a witness by another party, and present that evidence in this proceeding. The time to present such evidence will be determined at the prehearing conference described in the attached notice. As you may have been aware, Commonwealth Edison Company ("ComEd") is proposing to construct, operate, and maintain an overhead 345 kilovolt ("kV") electric transmission line through portions of Ogle, DeKalb, Kane, and DuPage Counties. In particular, the line would run from existing ComEd electric facilities near Byron, Illinois eastward to facilities located near Wayne, Illinois.

ComEd's proposal is the subject of ongoing proceedings at the Illinois Commerce Commission ("ICC") in what is known as Docket No. 13-0657. ComEd's Petition to the ICC, alternative proposals made by other parties, and other materials relating to the ICC proceeding review may be viewed using the ICC's web-based e-docket system, at <http://www.icc.illinois.gov/docket/casedetails.aspx?no=13-0657>. 
It has come to our attention that the tax assessor's office records identify you as the owner of record of the property referenced above. ComEd believes that this property is adjacent
