Please identify the source data for the six RZ I, II, and III "Price to Compare" prices in the second table on page 3 of Mr. Rubin's rebuttal.

Answer:

The Jan. 2014 price to compare is from the file: HistoricalPricestoCompare.xls downloaded from www.pluginillinois.com.

The Jan. 2015 price to compare is from www.pluginillinois.com.

The Zone I 2014 price is the rate effective in December 2013 for all consumption in Zone I (not Metro East), which would have been the predominant rate on Jan. 2014 bills. The data set provided to Mr. Rubin by Ameren during the initial phase of this case does not differentiate Metro East from other Zone I customers. The block 2 rate in Metro East in December 2013 was lower than the Zone I rate (4.418¢ vs. 4.887¢).

The Zone III 2014 price shown on Mr. Rubin's table is the rate for the first 800 kWh. Mr. Rubin should have used the rate for usage in excess of 800 kWh which was 4.709¢. This would change the Zone III difference to -0.268¢ instead of -0.391¢. The total bill changes should be +0.02077¢ for Ameren and +0.49377¢ for the AG.
