Once an emergency unit is dispatched in response to a request through the system, such unit shall render its' service to the requesting party without regard to whether the unit is operating outside its' normal jurisdictional boundaries.

E9-1-1 PARTICIPATING AGENCY AGREEMENT

UNION COUNTY EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM BOARD, with its principal place of business, Jonesboro, Union County, Illinois (hereinafter "**BOARD**") and **THE CITY OF ANNA, ILLINOIS**, a municipal Corporation (hereinafter "**CITY**"),

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, BOARD AND CITY desire to agree to the manner of routing by **BOARD** to City of 9-1-1 emergency calls requesting police and fire services in the corporate boundaries of **CITY**;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises and agreements of the parties, **BOARD** and **CITY** agree as follows:

SECTION 1. **BOARD**, upon receiving a 9-1-1 emergency call requesting police or fire services within **CITY**, shall dispatch the call in the following manner: **DIRECT DISPATCH**

PRIMARY: 9-1-1 Dispatch Frequency 159.150

SECONDARY: A remote printer located at the Anna Police and Fire Department will be used so that Automatic Number Identification/Automatic Location Identification information can be forwarded, and in the event **BOARD** is unable to Dispatch the call in this manner, **BOARD** shall transfer the call through low-band radio frequency 39.500 and/or regular telephone line.

SECTION 2. In the event **BOARD** dispatches a police or fire service unit in response to such request, it shall render the service to the requesting party, even though the unit may be required to operate outside the corporate boundaries of **CITY**:

SECTION 3. All calls from **BOARD** to **CITY** of administrative or non-emergency nature shall be made to 833-8571

The BOARD agrees to keep all records, times and places of all calls. All records will be available to CITY.

It shall be the responsibility of CITY to maintain the report of calls and the disposition of each call received.

All agreements, management, records and service will be the responsibility of the advisory and policy board.

Any agreement or changes in agreement and operating policies must be approved by the advisory board





E9-1-1 PARTICIPATING AGENCY AGREEMENT

This AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between the Union County Emergency Telephone System Board, 307 W Market St Rm 102, Jonesboro, Illinois, 62952, hereinafter referred to as "UCETSB", and the Jackson County Ambulance Service, herein referred to as "JCAS".

WHEREAS, The State of Illinois has enacted into law the "Emergency Telephone System Act" at 50 ILCS 750/0.01 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the voters of Union County, Illinois, did by a binding referendum at the General Election held November 3, 1992, pass by a majority of the votes cast upon the question a provision for imposing a surcharge in an amount not to exceed \$2.50 per month per network connection on telecommunication carriers for the purpose of installing and maintaining a 911 emergency telephone system; and

WHEREAS, the County of Union has acted into law various ordinances establishing a 911 emergency telephone system and an Emergency Telephone System Board known as the Union County Emergency Telephone System Board; and

WHEREAS, the UCETSB has established or will establish an enhanced 9-1-1 emergency telephone system for purposes of dispatching emergency services to the public and residents of Union County, Illinois, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to determine the manner and procedure for effective handling and routing of enhanced 9-1-1 emergency calls by and between Union County, Illinois, and the JCAS;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and of mutual covenants and agreements set forth herein, the UCETSB and the JCAS do hereby agree as follows:

The purpose of the Union County 911 System is to provide the most convenient and efficient emergency service possible to the citizens of Union County and its municipalities. In recognition of this purpose, the following call handling agreement has been devised to facilitate call answering

between and for the parties.

1. Should the JCAS receive a call for emergency services in the area served by the UCETSB PSAP, the call shall be transferred to the UCETSB PSAP located in Union County in the following manner:

PRIMARY: Via telephone number 618-833-5500

SECONDARY: In the event telephone communication is not possible, may contact the UCETSB PASP, over the Union County Sheriff's Department Frequency 158.775.

2. Should the UCETSB PSAP receive a call for emergency services in the area served by PCAS, the call shall be transferred to the JCETSB PSAP in the following manner:

PRIMARY: PSAP TO PSAP transfer or Via telephone number 1-618-684-2177

SECONDARY: In the event telephone communication is not possible, UCSD PSAP will contact the JCETSB PSAP via L.E.A.D.S. computer network or over the Low-Band radio frequency 39.500.

3. The parties agree to keep all record, times and places of the 9-1-1 calls on file as specified herein. All such records shall be available to the parties. The parties shall maintain records as required by the Illinois Commerce Commission including the reports of all calls, their times, and dispositions.

4. Once an emergency unit is dispatched in response to a 9-1-1 request for service and subsequently determines the address/location is outside of its jurisdiction, it shall render aid without regard to its jurisdictional boundaries until relieved.

5. Any other responses by agencies providing emergency service outside of their respective serving area, except as noted above, shall be made in accordance with established mutual aid procedures and agreements in effect at this time.

6. Any agreements or changes in agreements and /or operating policies must be approved by the parties hereto and any other agency providing emergency service which is effected.

The purpose of the Union County 911 System is to provide the most convenient and efficient emergency service possible to the citizens of Union County and its municipalities. In recognition

of this purpose, the following call handling agreement has been devised to facilitate call answering between and for the parties.

1. Should the WCAS receive a call for emergency services in the area served by the UCESTB PSAP, the call shall be transferred to the UCESTB PSAP located in Union County in the following manner:

PRIMARY: Via telephone number 618-833-5500

SECONDARY: In the event telephone communication is not possible, may contact the UCETSB PASP, over the Union County Sheriff's Department Frequency 158.775.

2. Should the UCESTB PSAP receive a call for emergency services in the area served by WCAS, the call shall be transferred to the WCETSB PSAP in the following manner:

PRIMARY: PSAP TO PSAP transfer or Via telephone number 1-618-997-6541

SECONDARY: In the event telephone communication is not possible, UCSD PSAP will contact the WCETSB PSAP via L.E.A.D.S. computer network or over the Low-Band radio frequency 39.500.

3. The parties agree to keep all record, times and places of the 9-1-1 calls on file as specified herein. All such records shall be available to the parties. The parties shall maintain records as required by the Illinois Commerce Commission including the reports of all calls, their times, and dispositions.

4. Once an emergency unit is dispatched in response to a 9-1-1 request for service and subsequently determines the address/location is outside of its jurisdiction, it shall render aid without regard to its jurisdictional boundaries until relieved.

5. Any other responses by agencies providing emergency service outside of their respective serving area, except as noted above, shall be made in accordance with established mutual aid procedures and agreements in effect at this time.

6. Any agreements or changes in agreements and /or operating policies must be approved by the parties hereto and any other agency providing emergency service which is effected.
