Whereas, the voters of Union County, Illinois, did by binding referendum at the General Election held November 3, 1992, pass by a majority of the votes cast upon the question a provision for imposing a surcharge in an amount not to exceed \$2.50 per month per network connection on telecommunication carriers for the purpose of installing and maintaining a 9-1-1 emergency telephone system; and

Whereas, the County of Union has acted into law various ordinances establishing a 9-1-1 Emergency Telephone System and an Emergency Telephone System Board known as the Union County Emergency Telephone System Board; and

Whereas, the UCETSB has established or will establish an enhanced 9-1-1 emergency telephone system for purposes of dispatching emergency services to the public and residents of Union County, Illinois, and

Whereas, it is necessary to determine the manner and procedure for effective handling and routing of enhanced 9-1-1 emergency calls by and between Union County, Illinois and the ACAS;

Now, Therefore, in consideration of the promises and of mutual covenants and agreements set forth herein, the UCETSB and the ACAS do hereby agree as follows:

The purpose of the Union County 9-1-1 System is to provide the most convenient and efficient emergency service to the citizens of Union County and its municipalities. In recognition of this purpose, the following call handling agreement has been devised to facilitate call answering between and for the parties.

1. Should ACAS receive a call for emergency services in the area served by the UCETSB PSAP, the call shall be transferred to the UCETSB PSAP located in Union County in the following manner:

PRIMARY: Via telephone number 1-618-833-5500

SECONDARY: In the event telephone communication is not possible, ACAS may contact the UCETSB PSAP via L.E.A.D.S. computer network.

2. Should the UCETSB PSAP receive a call for emergency services in the area served by ACAS, the call shall be transferred to the Alexander County Ambulance Service in the following manner:

PRIMARY: Via telephone number 1-618-776-5994

SECONDARY: In the event telephone communication is not possible, UCSD PSAP will contact the Alexander County Ambulance Service via L.E.A.D.S. computer network or via Alexander County Sheriff's Department telephone number 1-618-734-2141.

3. The parties agree to keep all record, times and places of the 9-1-1 calls on file as specified herein. All such records shall be available to the parties. The parties shall maintain records as required by the Illinois Commerce Commission including the reports of all calls, their times, and dispositions.

4. Once an emergency unit is dispatched in response to a 9-1-1 request for service and subsequently determines the address/location is outside of its jurisdiction, it shall render aid without regard to its jurisdictional boundaries until relieved.

5. Any other responses by agencies providing emergency service outside of their respective serving area, except as noted above, shall be made in accordance with established mutual aid procedures and agreements in effect at this time.

6. Any agreements or changes in agreements and/or operating policies must be approved by the parties hereto and any other agency providing emergency service which is effected.

SECONDARY: In the event telephone communication is not possible, UCSD PSAP will contact the JCETSB PSAP via L.E.A.D.S. computer network



5. Any other responses by agencies providing emergency service outside of their respective serving area, except as noted above, shall be made in accordance with established mutual aid procedures and agreements in effect at this time.

6. Any agreements or changes in agreements and /or operating policies must be approved by the parties hereto and any other agency providing emergency service which is effected.

This AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between the Union County Emergency Telephone System Board, P.O. Box F, Jonesboro, Illinois, 62952, hereinafter referred to as "UCETSB", and the Ullin Fire Department, herein referred to as "UFD".

Whereas, The State of Illinois has enacted into law the "Emergency Telephone System Act" at 50 ILCS 750/0.01 et seq.; and

Whereas, the voters of Union County, Illinois, did by binding referendum at the General Election held November 3, 1992, pass by a majority of the votes cast upon the question a provision for imposing a surcharge in an amount not to exceed \$2.50 per month per network connection on telecommunication carriers for the purpose of installing and maintaining a 9-1-1 emergency telephone system; and

Whereas, the County of Union has acted into law various ordinances establishing a 9-1-1 Emergency Telephone System and an Emergency Telephone System Board known as the Union County Emergency Telephone System Board; and

Whereas, the UCETSB has established or will establish an enhanced 9-1-1 emergency telephone system for purposes of dispatching emergency services to the public and residents of Union County, Illinois, and

Whereas, it is necessary to determine the manner and procedure for effective handling and routing of enhanced 9-1-1 emergency calls by and between Union County, Illinois and the UFD;

Now, Therefore, in consideration of the promises and of mutual covenants and agreements set forth herein, the UCETSB and the UFD do hereby agree as follows:

The purpose of the Union County 9-1-1 System is to provide the most convenient and efficient emergency service to the citizens of Union County and its municipalities. In recognition of this purpose, the following call handling agreement has been devised to facilitate call answering between and for the parties.

1. Should UFD receive a call for emergency services in the area served by the UCETSB PSAP, the call shall be transferred to the UCETSB PSAP located in Union County in the following manner:

PRIMARY: Via telephone number 1-618-833-5500

SECONDARY: In the event telephone communication is not possible, UFD may contact the UCETSB PSAP via L.E.A.D.S. computer network.

2. Should the UCETSB PSAP receive a call for emergency services in the area served by UFD, the call shall be transferred to the Ulin Fire Department in the following manner:

PRIMARY: Via telephone number 1-618-748-9374

SECONDARY: In the event telephone communication is not possible, UCSD PSAP will contact the Ulin Fire Department via L.E.A.D.S. computer network or via Pulaski County Sheriff's Department telephone number 1-618-748-9374.

3. The parties agree to keep all record, times and places of the 9-1-1 calls on file as specified herein. All such records shall be available to the parties. The parties shall maintain records as required by the Illinois Commerce Commission including the reports of all calls, their times, and dispositions.

4. Once an emergency unit is dispatched in response to a 9-1-1 request for service and subsequently determines the address/location is outside of its jurisdiction, it shall render aid without regard to its jurisdictional boundaries until relieved.

5. Any other responses by agencies providing emergency service outside of their respective serving area, except as noted above, shall be made in accordance with established mutual aid procedures and agreements in effect at this time.

6. Any agreements or changes in agreements and/or operating policies must be approved by the parties hereto and any other agency providing emergency service which is effected.

This AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between the Union County Emergency Telephone System Board, P.O. Box P, Jonesboro, IL 62952 hereinafter referred to as "UCETSB", and the U.S. Forest Service hereinafter referred to as "USFS."

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the State of Illinois, 1970, Article VII, Section 10, authorizes units of local government to contract or otherwise associate among themselves in any manner not prohibited by law or ordinance; and

WHEREAS, 5 ILCS 220/1 et seq. entitled the "Intergovernmental Cooperation Act," provides that any power or powers, privileges or authority exercised or which may be exercised by a public agency of this State may be exercised and enjoyed jointly with any other public agency of this State; and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted into law the "Emergency Telephone System Act" at 50 ILCS 750/0.01 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the voters of Union County, Illinois did by a binding referendum at the General Election held on November 2, 1992, pass by a majority of the votes cast upon the question a provision for imposing a surcharge in an amount not to exceed \$2.50 per month per network connection on telecommunication carriers for the purpose of installing and maintaining a 9-1-1 emergency telephone system; and

WHEREAS, the County of Union has enacted into law various ordinances establishing a 9-1-1 emergency telephone system and an Emergency Telephone System Board known as the Union County Emergency Telephone System Board; and

WHEREAS, the UCETSB has established or will establish an enhanced 9-1-1 emergency telephone system for purposes of dispatching emergency services to the public and residents of Union County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the USFS is a unit of government engaged in emergency services; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to determine the manner and procedure for effective handling and routing of enhanced 9-1-1 emergency calls;

NOW, THEREFORE in consideration of the promises and of the mutual covenants and agreements set forth herein, the UCETSB and the USFS does hereby agree as follows:

The purpose of the E9-1-1 System is to provide the most convenient and efficient emergency service possible to the citizens of Union County and its municipalities. In recognition of this purpose, the following call handling agreement has been devised to facilitate call answering between and for the parties.

1. 9-1-1 calls received for United States Forest Service property located within Union County will automatically be routed to the Union County Sheriff's Department Public Safety Answering Point (hereinafter referred to as PSAP) by Selective Routing Equipment.

2. 9-1-1 requests for the USFS will be received and accepted at the Union County Sheriff's Department PSAP. After receiving a call for emergency services within the area served by the USFS in Union County, the call for emergency service will be dispatched via one of the methods listed below:

Primary Dispatch

Phone 833-8576

Secondary Dispatch

Radio frequency ^{154.770} 164.825

3. The Union County Sheriff's Department PSAP shall dispatch those agencies that they receive 9-1-1 calls for as per guidelines set forth by the Union County Sheriff's Department PSAP, UCETSB and the agency being dispatched and rules and regulations established by the Illinois Commerce Commission.

4. The USFS agrees to keep all records, times and places of the 9-1-1 calls on file as specified herein. All such records shall be available to UCETSB. The PSAP shall maintain records as required by the Illinois Commerce Commission and the UCETSB including the reports of all calls, their times and their dispositions.

5. The USFS shall maintain a seven digit phone number which shall be utilized for the receipt of all calls that are of an administrative or non-emergency nature.

6. In instances where the Union County Sheriff's Department PSAP refuses a 9-1-1 request on the basis that the request is out of their jurisdictional boundaries, the PSAP's telecommunicator "SHALL" make every effort to redetermine the appropriate responding agency and complete the disposition of the call by transferring the call to the correct PSAP.

7. Once an emergency unit is dispatched in response to a 9-1-1 request for service and subsequently determines the address/location is outside of its jurisdiction, it shall render aid without regard to jurisdictional boundaries until relieved.

8. Any and all other responses by agencies providing emergency service outside of their respective serving areas, except as noted above, shall be made in accordance with established mutual aid procedures and agreements in effect at this time.

9. Any agreements or changes in agreements and/or operating policies must be approved by the UCETSB, the USFS and any other agency providing emergency service which is effected.
