Has the IL Chamber or its related Foundation received financial contributions, donations or other payments or in-kind donations from ComEd since 2010? If so, please specify the amounts or in-kind donations received and the dates.

**RESPONSE:**

The Illinois Chamber of Commerce ("ILCC") objects to this request because it seeks information that is neither relevant nor likely to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence in this docket. Without waiving this objection, the ILCC states as follows.

Yes. Based on a review of its records, ILCC states that ComEd made the following payments of membership dues to the ILCC on the dates in parentheses: \$35,000 (July 1, 2010); \$37,000 (August 17, 2011); \$35,000 (August 27, 2012); and \$35,000 (September 5, 2013). Answering further, Exelon has provided the following sponsorship payments to the ILCC: \$2,500 (July 18, 2012); \$1,500 (August 1, 2012); \$1,500 (May 1, 2013); \$5,000 (May 19, 2014); and \$3,000 (July 22, 2014).
