Dear Madam,

I have been requested to submit, in a letter of explanation, how I am qualified for a certificate, from the Illinois Commerce Commission, to install and maintain electric charging equipment. I have over forty-two years experience in the field of practical application and book theory, in the installation, maintenance, and repair of electrical wiring and equipment. I have taken and passed a test, issued by the Department of Buildings, City of Chicago, approximately twenty years ago, and have remained in good standing since that time. The requirements needed, in order to take the supervising electrician's test, are as follows: minimum of 21 y.o.a., minimum of 2 years experience in the installation, repair, and maintenance of electrical wires, equipment, and apparatus, or an experience equivalent thereto. Applicants shall furnish the names and addresses of former employers, periods of times employed by each, and in what capacity. Due to the amount of time that has passed, I contacted the Building Department, in order to get a copy of the letter provided, that allowed me to qualify to take the exam. Because of the time span, I was informed that they had no idea where to look for the letter. I submitted a copy of my current electrical contractor's/supervising electrician's license, with the paperwork initially sent to your office, on or about 08-April-2014. This should serve as proof that I am qualified to perform electrical work correctly and per code requirements. The duties of a supervising electrician are to either perform the work or directly supervise the installation, alteration, repair, and maintenance of electrical equipment and apparatus, authorized by permits issued under the authority of Chapter 13 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, and countersign all permits. I began working as an electrician's apprentice in 1968, and completed my apprenticeship 1973. During that time, I have gone through all the required training to become a journeyman electrician. In closing, I believe that I have provided all necessary information to have this certification issued to my company. If you have any further questions, please feel free to contact me.


