1. Q. Please identify yourself.
2. A. My name is Jennifer J Brown, 9-1-1 Director for Clay County
3. Emergency Telephone System Board with office at 123 N Locust St., Flora Illinois
4. 62839.
5. Q. What are your qualifications?
6. A. I have been employed in public safety for over 16 years. I began my public safety
7. career at Flora Police Department where I started as a TC 2000, and became dispatch
8. supervisor in 2004. I am also the Department's training officer. In 2005, I was hired by the
9. Clay County Emergency Telephone System Board to serve as the Director to complete
10. the County-wide E9-1-1 system. I oversaw the development and implementation of the
11. enhanced 9-1-1 system which was approved by the Illinois Commerce Commission in
12. January 6th, 2005 and cut live March 2006. I was named as the Coordinator of the Clay
13. County 9-1-1 System and I am responsible for all aspects of the 9-1-1 operations and
14. accountable to the Clay County Emergency Telephone System Board.
15. Q. What is the purpose of your testimony?
16. A. To declare, the foregoing Petition, Narrative and Exhibits 1 through 9, and 12 through

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17. 12.6 and that said contents are true in substance and in fact to the best of my knowledge.
18. I am willing to stand for testimony regarding such.
19. Q. Is additional testimony by others required to support the Petition?
20. A. Yes. I will defer to NG-911, Inc. for testimony regarding Exhibits 10, Exhibit 10.1, 10.2

22. Q. Do you agree that if, in the future, access carriers desire to connect directly, a plan
23. modification would need to be filed with the Commission?
24. A. Yes. Clay County Emergency Telephone System Board agrees that any changes in the
25. connection of access carriers in the future would require Commission approval and Clay
26. County Emergency Telephone System Board would file a plan modification.
