

1. The high voltage power lines were originally installed in a non-linear configuration. The pole just west of 743 W. Bittersweet is the only pole with the support beam facing north. Along the rest of the block, the support beams all face to the south. This configuration causes the power lines to encroach beyond a six foot setback on the southern border of the property of 743 W. Bittersweet. The current configuration will cause the lines to touch a proposed renovation of the building.

2. The high voltage lines are positioned at an angle over the rear area of the property, as shown in the attached diagram. An informal complaint (2014-12085) was filed with the Consumer Services Division. On September 10th, 2014, Commonwealth Edison tried to close the complaint, stating that the issues had been resolved. I objected to closing the complaint. I was contacted by Supervisor New Business for Commonwealth Edison Teshome Maru (773-509-5822), who conducted a site visit to investigate and document the problem. Mr. Maru stated that prior to any additional work commencing, Commonwealth Edison's legal department would need to investigate the utility easement for the property. He stated this process would take approximately three weeks. Two months had elapsed and numerous voice messages to Mr. Maru's phone went unanswered. He left a voice message at the beginning of December stating that it is my financial responsibility to move the lines. A request for a copy of the utility easement has never been provided.
