PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE

Pursuant to §200.200 of the Rules of Practice of the Illinois Commerce Commission (“Commission”), 83 ILL. ADMIN. CODE 200.200, O.L. Behymer, Wilma Behymer, Tamara Behymer, and Terry Behymer (“Behymer Parties”), by and through their attorneys, Shay Phillips, Ltd., file this Petition for Leave to Intervene (their “Intervention”), seeking authority thereby to intervene and participate fully as parties in the above-captioned proceeding. In support of their Intervention, Behymer Parties state as follows:

1. On December 22, 2014, Dakota Access, LLC (“Dakota Access”) filed its Application for Certificate in Good Standing and Other Relief (“Application”) seeking authority to construct and operate a petroleum pipeline as a common carrier pipeline and to take private property through eminent domain.

2. In its Application, Dakota Access describes a notification corridor for a preliminary proposed route in widths varying from 3,960 feet to 19,800 feet, and states that it will submit during this proceeding, if and as necessary, a

revised proposed route for Illinois Commerce Commission (“Commission”) approval.

3. The Behymer Parties have an interest, through trusts or otherwise, in the same properties that are relevant to this proceeding, all with an address at 7 Highland Park Drive, Mt. Sterling, Illinois 62353.

4. Behymer Parties’ properties are listed in Exhibit G to the Application as owners of land located within the notification corridor.

5. Accordingly, Behymer Parties are interested in the subject matter of this proceeding and may be affected by any order entered or other relief granted by the Commission.

6. No other party is able adequately to represent or protect Behymer Parties’ interests.

7. Behymer Parties agree to accept service by electronic means as provided for in §200.1050 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice. 83 ILL. ADMIN. CODE §200.1050.


