ORDER

By the Commission:

On January 23, 2015, TeleManagement Systems, Inc. (“Petitioner”) filed a verified petition requesting that the Commission cancel its Certificate of Service Authority to provide resold interexchange service in Illinois pursuant to Section 13-404 of the Act (220 ILCS 5/13-404) (“the Act”), granted in Docket 05-0370, August 3, 2005. Petitioner states that it has not had any customers or business in Illinois since December 31, 2013. Petitioner states that it will complete the AR-13 and Annual Gross Revenue Return for 2013.

Since all of the information necessary to grant the requested relief is contained in the petition, no hearing is necessary and it is waived.

A review of the Illinois Secretary of State’s records discloses that Petitioner was a Colorado corporation whose corporate status had been withdrawn on December 17, 2013. The Commission finds that, insofar as Petitioner has no customers in Illinois, withdrawal of Petitioner’s Certificate of Service Authority will not deprive Illinois customers of any necessary telecommunications service and is not otherwise contrary to the public interest. Petitioner should be directed to file its AR-13, Annual Gross Revenue Return for 2013, and its 2013 Annual Report within 60 days of the date of this Order. Petitioner’s tariff should also be canceled.

The Commission having reviewed the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, is of the opinion and finds that:

- (1) Petitioner was a Colorado corporation that furnished telecommunications service to customers in Illinois and, as such, was a telecommunications carrier within the meaning of Section 13-202 of the Act (220 ILCS 5/13-202).
- (2) the Commission has jurisdiction over Petitioner and the subject matter herein;
- (3) on August 3, 2005, Petitioner was granted a Certificate of Service Authority in Docket 05-0370 to provide resold interexchange service in Illinois, pursuant to Section 13-404 of the Act;

- (4) January 23, 2015, Petitioner filed a petition to withdraw the Certificate of Service Authority previously issued in Docket 05-0370;
- (5) Petitioner has no Illinois customers, therefore discontinuance of service by Petitioner will not deprive Illinois customers of any necessary services and is not otherwise contrary to the public interest;
- (6) Petitioner's tariff to provide resold interexchange service should be canceled;
- (7) Petitioner should file its AR-13, Annual Gross Revenue Return for 2013, and its 2013 Annual Report within 60 days of the date of this order;
- (8) the petition should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Illinois Commerce Commission that the petition of TeleManagement Systems, Inc. to cancel the Certificate Service Authority previously issued in Docket 05-0370, is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner's tariff to provide resold interexchange service in Illinois is canceled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner shall file its AR-13, Annual Gross Revenue Return for 2013, and 2013 Annual Report within 60 days of the date of this Order, in compliance with Finding (7) above.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that subject to the provisions of Section 10-113 of the Public Utilities Act and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 200.880, this Order is final; it is not subject to the Administrative Review Law.
