PETITION FOR CONFIDENTIAL PROPRIETARY TREATMENT

TELUS Communications (U.S.) Inc. ("TELUS U.S." or the "Company"), through its undersigned counsel, respectfully requests that the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission") afford proprietary treatment of its 2014 Annual Report, and, further, that it accept this form simultaneous with the filing of the 2014 Annual Report. In support of its petition, TELUS U.S. states as follows:

1. The Attached 2014 Annual Report contains TELUS U.S.'s commercial and financial information, which is highly sensitive and would be of interest to TELUS U.S.'s competitors and potential competitors. The Company does not otherwise make this information public, and takes active steps to prevent disclosure of such information.


2. Due to the sensitive nature of the information contained in the report, TELUS U.S. respectfully requests that the Commission maintain the information contained in the Annual Report for a period of no less than two years. Disclosure prior to two years likely would cause competitive harm to TELUS U.S.

3. Grant of this Petition is consistent with Section 7(1)(g) of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/7(g)(1994), which exempts from public disclosure "trade secrets and commercial or financial information... where such trade secrets or information are proprietary, privileged or confidential." TELUS U.S.'s Annual Report, which contains financial information, falls within this exemption.

4. TELUS U.S. further requests that the Commission grant this petition as timely filed, and afford confidential treatment of the Annual Report as of the date of filing of the Annual Report.

WHEREFORE, TELUS Communications (U.S.) Inc. respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order granting proprietary treatment and protecting from disclosure in its entirety for a period of not less than two years, the company's 2014 Annual Report.


