NARRATIVE STATEMENT

The Village of Calumet Park requests to resume dispatching within the Village of Calumet Park.

The Village of Calumet Park has built a new facility to serve as its primary PSAP. The Village of Calumet Park has the necessary equipment and personnel to provide dispatch communication services for up to ten (10) towns. The facility will be housed in a new purpose built facility located at 12419 S. Ashland, Calumet Park, Illinois. The facility will have six (6) active positions upon opening with the ability to expand should the need arise.

It is a one story brick and concrete building, built to withstand up to 190 mph winds. It has both Universal Power Supply (UPS) and diesel generator back-up, and an additional generator plug-in should the main generator need service. It has redundant heating and cooling systems. It has an electronic keyless entry system requiring keycards for entry beyond the bullet proof lobby. There are "man traps" designed to isolate intruders using high security doors and electronic entry should someone make it passed the secure lobby. The facility has multiple security cameras that can be viewed from any number of interior locations.

The facility will be using Airbus VESTA NG-911 with the ability to take both the legacy TTY and Text to 911. It is fully ALI/ANI capable. That system will be paired with Motorola MCC7500 radios. There will be a video matrix system in place with the ability to take in both analog and digital video feeds from multiple sources (traffic cameras, schools, banks, etc.). We will be using the USDD firehouse notification system, which alerts EMS/Fire both visually and audibly when required. Additionally, there will be a CAPERS CAD system for electronic dispatch of police calls.

The City of Blue Island 9-1-1 PSAP will be the backup PSAP for the Village of Calumet Park.







AGREEMENT

Alternate Public Safety Answering Point

For 9-1-1 Emergency Communications

This Agreement is made between the Village of Calumet Park 911 Board and the City of Blue Island for the purpose of effective handling and routing of E-911 and wireless 911 emergency calls for police/fire assistance.


Call Handling

When the volume of emergency calls at the CalComm Dispatch Center in Calumet Park is such that an overflow of emergency calls is produced, the overflow of emergency calls will be transferred to the City of Blue Island Police Department. The Blue Island Police Department, located at 13051 Greenwood Ave., Blue Island, IL 60406 will service as the backup Public Safety Answering Point, and will be utilized in the event that the primary Public Safety Answering Point becomes inoperable, providing the Blue Island Police Department is physically capable of receiving such calls.

It would then become the receiving center for all emergency public safety services provided to the Village of Calumet Park.
