**VERIFIED PETITION TO INTERVENE OF  
AMEREN ILLINOIS COMPANY**

COMES NOW Ameren Illinois Company d/b/a Ameren Illinois (AIC), by its undersigned attorneys, pursuant to 83 Ill. Admin. Code § 200.200, and hereby respectfully petitions the Illinois Commerce Commission (Commission) for leave to intervene and participate in this docket. In support of this Petition, AIC states as follows:

1. This docket was initiated by the Illinois Power Agency (IPA) filing its Petition for Approval of the 220 ILCS 5/16 111.5(d) Procurement Plan (Petition) on September 28, 2015. Attached to the Petition is the IPA's Draft Power Procurement Plan for the period beginning June 2016 through May 2021 (Procurement Plan). The IPA has submitted to the Commission its proposed plan for the procurement of electricity for certain retail customers of AIC.
2. AIC has an interest in the subject matter of this docket, and cannot be adequately represented by any other party in this case. The IPA's Procurement Plan sets forth a procurement approach that will secure power and energy supply products to meet the supply needs of eligible retail customers served by AIC. AIC is required to procure power and energy for eligible retail customers according to the applicable provisions of Section 1-75 of the Illinois Power Agency Act and Section 16-115 of the

Public Utilities Act. Because AIC is required to purchase power and energy products to serve its customers pursuant to the IPA's Procurement Plan, AIC should be permitted to participate as a party in this case.

3. AIC agrees to accept service by electronic means as provided for in Section 200.1050 of the Commission's Rules of Practice. 83 Ill. Admin. Code §200.1050.


