In addition, the Commission staff in its Objections to the IPA 2016 Procurement Plan recommends that the Commission reject the four programs referred to as “performance risk” by ComEd. ERC believes it has important information for the Commission to consider in its deliberations on the IPA’s Petition that it would like to file as a Response to ComEd’s Objections, if granted leave to intervene and leave to file a Response beyond the October 20th deadline.
