

**NARRATIVE STATEMENT
MENDOTA EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM BOARD**

The narrative statement in the Mendota ETSB's original petition remains the same. There will be a new agreement with Livingston County's ETSB to serve as a backup PSAP to the City of Mendota ETSB system.

This modification is required because the City of Streator ETSB has advised that it intends to dissolve and join the Livingston County 9-1-1 Emergency Telephone System Board ("Livingston County 9-1-1").

An intergovernmental agreement has been agreed to and signed by both the City of Mendota ETSB Chairman and the Livingston County ETSB Chairman. A copy of the Agreement is attached to the Mendota ETSB Petition for Modification.

NARRATIVE STATEMENT 2

There will be a new backup agreement with Livingston County PSAP, to serve as backup PSAP to the City of Mendota PSAP.

The purpose of the modification is to secure a backup PSAP that has the capability to answer Landline and Wireless Enhanced 9-1-1 calls. Livingston County PSAP currently has this capability. The Livingston County PSAP is located at 844 W. Lincoln St., Pontiac, IL 61764. The Livingston County PSAP has 5 primary 9-1-1 call taking positions. The City of Streator ETSB will no longer serve as backup to the City of Mendota ETSB, given the approval of this modification request.

An intergovernmental agreement has been agreed to and signed by both the Livingston County ETSB Chairman and the City of Mendota ETSB Chairman.

9-1-1 Calls for service for the City of Mendota PSAP, which are answered by the Livingston County PSAP under this backup agreement, dispatched in the following manner:

- 1) 9-1-1 Calls for Service shall be transferred to the 9-1-1 trunks for the City of Mendota.
- 2) In the event that the calls cannot be transferred to the 9-1-1 trunks, calls shall be transferred to (815) 844-0911 (the 10 digit administrative line answered at the PSAP)
- 3) In the event 1 and 2 above are not possible, emergency services will be dispatched by radio / Star Com Group.

These mutually beneficial agreements are possible, as both the City of Mendota ETSB and the Livingston County ETSB are served by Frontier, Bloomington selective router.



INTERGOVERNMENTAL
AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, THE CITY OF MENDOTA (CITY) has requested the EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM BOARD OF LIVINGSTON COUNTY (LIV/COM), PONTIAC, ILLINOIS to provide E911 backup services for the CITY in the event that the CITY E911 System is not functioning.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED by and between the CITY and Livingston County ETSB as following:


1. Requested services. Livingston County ETSB agrees to provide E911 backup services for CITY in the event that the CITY E911 system is not functioning (the Requested Services).
2. Authority. For and during any period that any personnel of Livingston County ETSB are performing the Requested Services, such personnel shall be under the authority and direction of Livingston County ETSB.
3. Reimbursement. CITY hereby agrees to reimburse Livingston County ETSB for any wages paid to its personnel and any expenses incurred by Livingston County ETSB in connection with providing the Requested Services. Livingston County ETSB shall submit a request for such reimbursement from CITY detailing the number of hours for which any personnel were furnished together with the total amount of any expense incurred. Upon receipt of any such request for reimbursement CITY shall pay such total reimbursable amount within forty-five (45) days after receipt of such request.
4. Other Liabilities. Except as otherwise provided this Agreement, CITY shall be solely responsible for any and all liability, obligation and does hereby indemnify Livingston County ETSB against damages or loss incurred by Livingston County ETSB arising out of or in connection with furnishing the Requested Services.
5. Notices and Communications. All notices, demands, requests for reimbursement or other communications under or in respect of this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been given when the same are (i) deposited in the United States mail and sent by first class mail, postage prepaid or (ii) delivered, in each case, to Livingston County ETSB and CITY as follows:
 - 5.1 If to Livingston County ETSB, at 844B W. Lincoln Street, Pontiac, IL 61764, Attn: Livingston County ETSB Coordinator;
 - 5.2 If to CITY, at 610 Main Street, Mendota, IL 61342, Attn: ETSB Board Chairman.




6. Illinois Law. This agreement shall be deemed to be an intergovernmental agreement made under and shall be construed in accordance with and governed by the laws of the State of Illinois.
7. Written Modification. This Agreement may not be changed, revised, modified, waived, discharged, terminated or otherwise abrogated, diminished or impaired other than by an instrument in writing duly authorized and executed by both Livingston County ETSB and CITY.
8. Effective Date and Term. This agreement shall become effective upon its execution and delivery both parties and shall be and remain in full force and effect thereafter until terminated by written notice at least thirty (30) days before the date of the termination.
9. Entire Agreement. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the Livingston County ETSB and CITY on the subject matter hereof. CITY represents, warrants, covenants and agrees that no representation, warranty, covenant or agreement shall be binding on Livingston County ETSB unless expressed in writing herein or by written modification pursuant to §8 hereof.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, LIVINGSTON COUNTY ETSB and CITY OF MENDOTA have each caused this Agreement to be executed by proper offices duly authorized to execute the same as of the date set forth beneath the signatures of their respective officers set forth below.


