Petition (1) to install a pre-signal on the northbound approach of
IL 1 of the at-grade crossing of TP&W's single main line track,
(2) to interconnect the newly installed traffic signals at the
intersection of IL 1 and U.S. 24 with the railroad warning devices
at the IL 1 at-grade crossing of the TP&W single main line track
and (3) to establish the amount of minimum preemption time
provided by TP&W to the Department for the traffic signal
preemption sequence at said intersection, located in Watseka,
Illinois.

MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

NOW COMES the State of Illinois, Department of Transportation (the
"Department") and moves the Illinois Commerce Commission for an extension of time
to complete work ordered in the above cause of action and in support of said Motion
states:

- 1) On November 21, 2000, the Illinois Commerce Commission entered an Order regarding the above described subject matter.
- 2) Pursuant to the November 21, 2000 Order, the Department was to have completed the installation of a pre-signals south of the IL 1 at-grade crossing including the installation of an over head traffic signal on the railroad cantilever by November 21, 2001.
- 3) The Department's completion of the aforementioned work has been delayed primarily due to the site specific constraints in the placement of crossing warning devices, which required additional ICC Staff consideration.



4) The Department has been working diligently on this matter and, in fact, construction of the new signal is currently under way; however, the Department does not anticipate complete installation until November 21, 2002.

WHEREFORE, the Department prays for an extension of time until November 21, 2002 to complete the work ordered to be completed by the Department in the November 21, 2000 Order.

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


