SUBJECT: W.J. Burke Electric

Application for Certification as an Installer of Distributed Generation Facilities under Section 16-128A of the Public Utilities Act.

RECOMMENDATION: Enter the attached Order granting the requested certificate of service authority.

I. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On June 27, 2016, W.J. Burke Electric (“Applicant”) filed a verified application with the Illinois Commerce Commission (“Commission”) requesting a certificate of service authority to operate as an installer of distributed generation facilities in Illinois pursuant to Section 16-128A of the Public Utilities Act (“Act”). The Applicant requests authority to offer services as an Installer of Distributed Generation Facilities for photovoltaic distributed generation technology in the State of Illinois. Staff filed its verified statement on July 21, 2016.

II. ISSUE

A. Whether W.J. Burke Electric should be granted a certificate of service authority to operate as an installer of distributed generation in Illinois pursuant to Section 16- 128A of the Public Utilities Act.

Staff performed a thorough review of the Application and recommended that the Applicant be granted a certificate of service authority.

III. CONCLUSION

I recommend that the Commission adopt the Order granting the requested certificate of service authority.
