The 2019 Illinois Power Agency (“IPA”) Procurement Plan, in its final form as approved by the Illinois Commerce Commission, requires that Ameren Illinois notify the Commission, the IPA, and the SAG whenever a contract with an IPA energy efficiency program vendor cannot be reached, or when any such program is terminated. *See* 2016 IPA Procurement Plan at Page 94. The Final Order entered by the Illinois Commerce Commission in Docket No. 15-0541 contains the same language, at Page 37. In accordance with this language, please see the attached letters for filing in Docket No. 15-0541, so that it might serve as notice to the Commission and the IPA.

Dear Mr. Braatz,

Despite our mutual best efforts to structure the Nexant—HVAC energy efficiency program (“Program”) in such a way as to be cost-effective under the Illinois Total Resource Cost test, I regret to inform you that Ameren Illinois Company is unable to proceed any further with contract negotiations or implementation of the program.

In its Final Order approving the 2016 Illinois Power Agency Electricity Procurement Plan, the Illinois Commerce Commission (“ICC”) made clear that Ameren Illinois must “use reasonable and prudent judgment” in negotiating and/or modifying the terms of vendor contracts to ensure that those vendors’ programs actually do “continue to result in a cost-effective [energy efficiency] program.” ICC Docket No. 15-0541, Final Order (Dec. 16, 2015), at 36. Because the Program is not planned to be cost-effective at this time, we are not in a position to contract for or implement the Program.

Thank you for your interest in participating in energy efficiency initiatives in Illinois, and we look forward to a future opportunity to work together.

I am writing on behalf Ameren Illinois Company (AIC) to provide notice of AIC's termination of the above referenced Statement of Work pursuant to Miscellaneous Terms #3 of the SOW 02 which states as follows:

Should the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) obtain funding and authorization to proceed with its Public Sector Energy Efficiency Programs for PY9, AIC may initiate its right to terminate the administration of the Public Facilities Direct Install Program 30 days after DCEO obtains such authorization.

As you are aware, effective June 30, 2016, the State of Illinois passed a budget for fiscal years 2016 and 2017 which appropriated funding to implement DCEO programs.
