1 MR. DEARMONT: I'll pick up the
2 phone. Is that better?

3 JUDGE VON QUALEN: Yes. Thank you.

4 MR. DEARMONT: This is Eric Dearmont
5 with Ameren Illinois Company d/b/a Ameren Illinois.

8 MS. HATHHORN: Dianna Hathhorn. I'm
9 an accountant in the financial analysis division in
10 the Illinois Commerce Division. My business address

12 62701, and my phone number is (217)785-5426.

13 JUDGE VON QUALEN: Are there any
14 others wishing to enter an appearance?

15 (No response.)

16 JUDGE VON QUALEN: Let the record
17 show no response.

18 This matter comes on for a status
19 hearing this morning. I have received
20 Ms. Hathhorn's testimony, and it appears there are
21 no issues between the company and staff. Do the
22 parties wish to proceed to enter their testimony
23 into evidence?

24 MS. HATHHORN: Yes.

25 MR. DEARMONT: Yes.

1 JUDGE VON QUALEN: Very well then.

2 Mr. Dearmont?

3 MR. DEARMONT: Thanks, Judge.

4 At this time, Ameren Illinois would
5 move for the admission of Ameren Exhibit 1.0
6 revised, representing the revised direct testimony
7 of Ameren witness Stephanie Gentry. That testimony
8 was filed on June 24th of this year.

9 We would also move for the admission
10 of Ameren Exhibit 1.1 revised, representing a
11 revised exhibit to the revised direct testimony of
12 Ms. Gentry. That document was also filed on
13 June 24th of this year.

14 Finally, with your permission, we
15 would move for the admission of what will be Ameren
16 Exhibit 1.2, representing the late-filed affidavit
17 of Stephanie Gentry.

18 JUDGE VON QUALEN: Does Staff have
19 any objection to those exhibits?

20 MS. HATHHORN: No.

21 JUDGE VON QUALEN: And Ameren
22 Exhibit 1.0 revised, 1.1 revised, and Ameren
23 Exhibit 1.2 to be filed, which is the affidavit, are
24 admitted into evidence. Thank you, Mr. Dearmont.

5 MS. HATHHORN: This is Dianna
6 Hathhorn.

7 I request ICC Staff Exhibit 1.0,
8 which is the direct testimony of Dianna Hathhorn,
9 filed on August 15, 2016, be admitted, as well as
10 ICC Staff Exhibit 1.1, which is my affidavit, also
11 filed August 15, 2016, be admitted into evidence.

12 JUDGE VON QUALEN: Mr. Dearmont, does
13 the Company have any objection to Staff's exhibits?

14 MR. DEARMONT: No objection.

15 JUDGE VON QUALEN: Then ICC Staff
16 Exhibits 1.0 and 1.1 are entered into evidence.

17 (ICC Staff Exhibits 1.0 and 1.1 are
18 admitted into evidence.)

19 JUDGE VON QUALEN: I see,
20 Ms. Hathhorn, that you've recommended that Page 4 of
21 Ameren Exhibit 1.1 revised be attached to the final
22 order.

23 Mr. Dearmont, could you provide me an
24 Excel copy of that please?

25 MR. DEARMONT: I would be glad to.

1 And would you like us to prepare a draft order for
2 your review, or did you plan to do that, Judge?

3 JUDGE VON QUALEN: Either way is fine
4 with me. I'm running slow right now, so a draft
5 order might be a good idea.

6 MR. DEARMONT: Okay. If we provided
7 something to you in about a month, would that be too
8 long?

9 JUDGE VON QUALEN: No.

10 MR. DEARMONT: We can provide one to
11 Ms. Hathhorn in three weeks or so.

12 JUDGE VON QUALEN: That would be fine
13 with me.

14 MR. DEARMONT: If -- Dianna, if it
15 works for you, we'll provide a copy of that the week
16 of the 24th with the goal to provide it to the
17 judge the next week, the week of October 31st.

18 MS. HATHHORN: That's fine with me.

19 MR. DEARMONT: Very good.

21 me also.
