1. All sub-contractors, electrical, for grading, excavating, roads, streets, have been notified that they are not to go on the property for any investigation, facts, that could benefit me or them, I consider it trespassing.
2. If sub-contractors wish to rely on my suit and my gratuity that is their business, because all partners, sub-contractors, etc. are free to put in their own suits.
3. The attorney for Com-Ed had a document in his possession, that was suppose to be square footage and a plan of the building we were suppose to build in 1992. But, when I noticed it was on their letterhead they put it back in their file, and I would like to have it.
4. I would like the court reporter to type all conversation, because after Judge Sainsot shut down the reporter that benefited Com-Ed, I would like all conversation on record.
5. Regarding sentence four, I consider nothing on transcript very prejudicial, and that makes me tell Com-Ed all the things that they have done wrong, and I consider it prejudicial by Judge Sainsot and if the rules are the same here as they in court, I would suggest a substitution of Judge.

6. There is a lot of prices that have not been put down, for instance, five acres of trees 70ft. high, cut and the stumps pulled out then taken to a dump plus a road five hundred feet with trees the roads are thirty feet wide, and use a minimum four inches of hard rock and four inches of soft rock, graded, dug out, etc. We are talking in the hundred of thousands of dollars. Etc.
7. I do not feel like talking from May until December and Com-Ed pretends that they do not know what you are talking about, for every thing from discrimination to damage of property, running sales, discouraging potential buyers, not giving electric, this is been a long on going terrible ordeal.
