**SUBJECT:** Central Illinois Public Service Company (AmerenCIPS) and  
Union Electric Company (AmerenUE)

Request for approval of revisions to delivery services tariffs,  
and for approval of Delivery Services Implementation Plan  
for Residential Customers.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Entry of the previously distributed post exceptions proposed  
order ("PEPO"), which was before the Commission for  
consideration on December 5.

---

In this proceeding, Ameren proposes revisions to its delivery services tariffs. Among other things, delivery services would be made available to residential customers. Pursuant to 16-104(a)(4) of the Act, such services must be offered before May 1, 2002. Under 16-108(b), an order must be entered at least 30 days before the date on which the delivery services must commence. Under 16-105, the implementation plan is to be approved at least 60 days prior to the commencement date.

The previously distributed PEPO is not attached to this memorandum.
